# Florida Chautauqua Assembly 2020

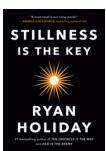

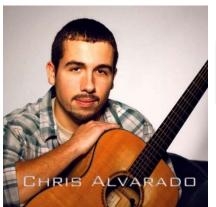
Our Saturday keynote speaker Pamela

This year, find out how The Honorable Winston Churchill found happiness during the most troubling times of his historic career.





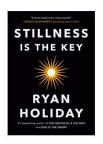
Do butterflies put a smile on your face?
