

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

FAPSC Foundation

The FAPSC Foundation's mission is to provide tuition assistance to qualifying individuals interested in pursuing education/careers through FAPSC member schools.

FAPSC Scholarship

Understanding the significance of career education, the FAPSC Foundation Scholarship was established to support eligible students who wish to pursue education and careers through FAPSC member schools. This scholarship offers tuition assistance to individuals committed to completing their career education and is awarded based on the excellence of the applicants.

Who May Apply

The applicant must meet admissions and eligibility requirements of the selected FAPSC member school(s).

How to Apply

Follow the steps below:

- 1. Complete the application
- 2. Include with this document a typed Personal Statement/Essay of no more than 500 words, addressing the following six elements:
 - a. A brief overview of your current situation.
 - b. Experiences that have motivated you to pursue education at a FAPSC member school (include the name of the school and your chosen program of study).
 - c. How these experiences will support your career choice.
 - d. Your personal goals and aspirations.
 - e. How education will help you achieve these goals.
 - f. Why the FAPSC Foundation should consider you for a scholarship.
 - **3.** Attach two letters of recommendation: These references should be from employers, associates, current or former instructors, or other parties qualified to speak to the applicant's character, commitment, and desire to continue their education
 - 4. Upon completion of application, sign, and date
 - **5.** Return the completed form to the FAPSC Foundation (application@FAPSCFoundation.org) before the deadline published for applications.

Incomplete or handwritten applications will not be considered

Deadline: The application packet, including the completed application, personal statement, and two letters of recommendation, must be submitted to the FAPSC Foundation by the specified deadline. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

Award Recipient Selection Process: The Foundation Board (or their designees) will review the applications using a provided rubric to ensure all applications receive equal consideration. The Board will evaluate the applications and recommendations and make the final decision on granting the scholarship. The scholarship recipient will be notified in writing, and the scholarship amount will be disbursed directly to the selected school in the student's name upon receipt of enrollment verification from the school.
