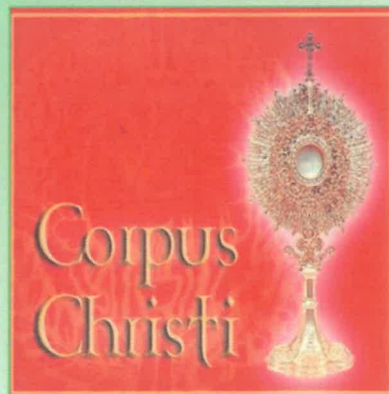
THE BODY AND BLOOD of Christ
