



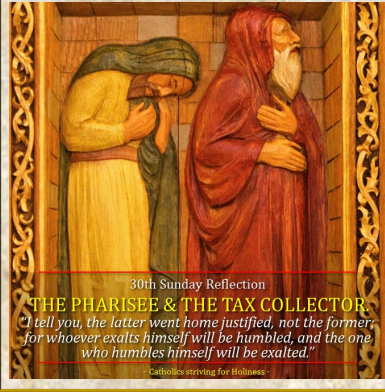

**Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled,
and the man who humbles himself will be exalted.**



Humble behavior is the mark of the Christian, as it always was the mark of someone in favour with the Lord. In the Gospel, we see Jesus watching the Pharisees: it's almost amusing to picture them shuffling for the best places, the polite After you! to put themselves in a better position. How would they have reacted to his teaching? They may well have remembered the passage we read from the Old Testament, and realized that Jesus was teaching the teachers something they should be well aware of.

It is common to expect reciprocity. We are likely to invite people to lunch or to our homes if they have extended an invitation to us. Jesus is asking for a different way of being when he says that those who cannot repay should be asked to the banquet. We can consider that God invites us to the heavenly banquet and we can never repay him.
