## **PREAMBLE**

We the Founding Members of the Association of Indian  
Students

Having common AIM to Constitute an Association for Students

To redress the grievances and to put the same before the  
appropriate authority,

To Provide Resource and help them to choose their path,

To help them in their academic pathway and make them  
successful in their goal. We Constitute this Association on the  
15<sup>th</sup> Day of August 2020.

We hereby adopt this Constitution to our self as the First Meet  
of the  
Founding Members.

**PART-I**  
**PRELIMINARY**

**1. Name of the Association:** - The name of the Association shall be “Association of Indian Students” that is “AIS”.

**2. Logo of the Association:** - The Logo of the Association shall be specified in schedule I.

**3. Slogan of the Association:** - The Slogan of the Association shall be specified in schedule II.

**4. Aims of the Association:** - The Aims & objectives of the Association shall be specified in schedule III.

**PART-II**  
**PRESIDENT**

**5. President: -**

(1) There shall be a President of the Association.

(2) The President shall be the head of the Association.

(3) The President shall use such powers and functions which he thinks fit proper to run the Association.

(4) All the Decisions shall only be implemented or deemed to be taken, only when President gives their Assent to that particular Decision.

**6. Other Office Holders:**

(1) The President may by notification appoint as such members to such offices as he thinks fit for that purpose.

(2) The President in such notification may fix the duties, responsibilities and other powers for that office.

(3) The person appointed under clause (1) shall hold office on the pleasure of the President.

(4) The President may direct such office holders to discharge such duties as in such manner as the President desired to do so.

### **PART-III**

## **ORGANS OF THE ASSOCIATION**

#### **7. Cabinet –**

(1) There shall be a Cabinet of the Association.

(2) The Cabinet shall consist of such offices as President may appoint under Article 6 (1).

(3) The Cabinet shall be the Top Decision-making body of the Association.

(4) The President shall preside the meeting of the Cabinet.

#### **8. Advisory Board-**

(1) There shall be an advisory board of the association.

(2) The advisory board shall consist of such members as appointed by the President.

(3) The advisory board shall provide advice to the association on various issues and matter concerned with association.

(4) The President shall preside on the meeting of advisory board.

#### **9. Executive Committee-**

(1) There shall be an Executive Committee of the Association.

(2) The Executive Committee shall consist of such offices as President may appoint under Article 6 (1).

(3) The Executive Committee shall be the Decision Implementing body of the Association.

(4) The President shall appoint an Office Holder to preside the meeting of the Executive Committee.

#### **10. Steering Committee-**

(1) There shall be a Steering Committee of the Association.

(2) The Steering Committee shall consist of such offices as President may appoint under Article 6 (1).

(3) The Steering Committee shall be the Day-by Day functioning body of the Association.

(4) The President shall appoint an Office Holder to preside the meeting of the Steering Committee.

#### **11. National Student Board-**

The President may under his hand and seal appoint National Student Board to Discuss the Grievances of the Students from the Country.

#### **12. National Student Council-**

The President may under his hand and seal constitute a Council to take the decisions in favour of Students in country.

#### **13. Discipline Committee-**

(1) There shall be a Discipline Committee of the Association.

(2) The Discipline Committee shall consist of such offices as President may appoint under Article 6 (1).

(3) The Discipline Committee shall be responsible for the Discipline of the Association.

(4) The President shall appoint an Office Holder to preside the meeting of the Discipline Committee.

#### **14. State Committee-**

(1) There shall be a State Committee of the Association in every state.

(2) The State Committee shall consist of such offices as President may appoint under Article 6 (1).

(3) The State Committee shall be responsible for the proper functioning of the Association in the state.

(4) The President shall appoint an Office Holder to preside the meeting of the Discipline Committee.

### **PART-IV**

### **FINANCE**

#### **15. Student Welfare Fund-**

- (1) President can establish student welfare funds through an official notification
- (2) Student Welfare Fund will be the treasury of the association
- (3) President shall appoint office holders to maintain record of the student welfare account.

## **PART V**

### **MISCELLENEOUS**

#### **16. Amendment to this Constitution –**

- (1) The Amendment of this Constitution shall made in the form of Repealing, Substitution or Insertion by a Resolution adopted in Executive Committee with the majority of not less than two-third of the total strength of the Executive Committee.
- (2) The Resolution must be approved with Cabinet & President before it can put for the vote.
- (3) The Resolution shall be moved in National Student Council meeting and if the Council adopt the resolution with not less than three-fourth of the members Present & voting, the constitution shall stand amend with the provision of that resolution.

**17. Residuary Power:** All the Residuary powers shall be rest with the President.

**18. Power to remove Difficulties:** The President shall have power to remove the difficulties under this Constitution.
