While in high school she has completed 24 dual credit hours and chose to take AP level classes in all her CORE classes.





# JULY PLANT OF THE MONTH: SPIGELIA MARILANDICA



Common Name	Indian Pink, Woodland Pinkroot, American Pink
Botanical Name	<i>Spigelia marilandica</i>
Family	Loganiaceae
Plant Type	Perennial
Mature Size	1-2 ft
Sun Exposure	Partial Shade
Soil Type	Adaptable
Soil pH	Slightly Acidic (6.1-6.5)
Bloom Time	Late spring to early summer
Flower Color	Deep Red to Scarlet
Hardiness Zones	5-9
Native Areas	Southeastern US
Toxicity	Can be in large quantities

Description: Indian Pink, scientifically known as *Spigelia marilandica*, is a herbaceous perennial native to North America. It is recognized for its striking red tubular flowers with yellow throats, which bloom primarily in late spring to early summer. These flowers are known to attract pollinators, especially hummingbirds, due to their color and shape. Indian Pink prefers partial shade but can tolerate full sun with adequate moisture. The plant thrives in rich, well-drained soil and benefits from regular watering, although it is somewhat drought-tolerant once established.
