JULY PLANT OF THE MONTH CAMELLIA







Camellias are a popular choice for gardens in Dallas, Texas, thanks to their evergreen nature, beautiful flowers, and adaptability to the local climate. These shrubs thrive in both full shade and filtered sunlight, making them versatile additions to any landscape. With their glossy, dark green foliage, camellias provide year-round visual interest even when not in bloom.

These flowers come in a variety of shades, including pinks, whites, and reds, and add a cheerful touch to the garden during the cooler months. Camellias prefer acidic soil and should be watered regularly to ensure healthy growth.

| Camellia sinensis | White | Spring | Large |


