


Biography



- 1. MAXIMUM OCCUPANCY FOR THE RESTAURANT IS 166 PEOPLE. FURTHER RESEARCH IS REQUIRED TO DETERMINE MAXIMUM OCCUPANCY FOR CAFE PORTION.
- 2. LOCATION OF CURRENT RESTROOM PLUMBING. RELOCATION MAY BE REOUIRED DEPENDING ON FINAL RESTROOM LOCATION
- 3. LOCATION OF REAR ENTRY. POSSIBLY TO BE USED FOR DELIVERY AND/OR RECEIVING CHEF'S TABLE GUESTS.
- 4. ENTRANCE TO KITCHEN AT THIS LOCATION.
- 5. CURRENT KITCHEN PLUMBING LOCATION. RELOCATION MAY BE REQUIRED DEPENDING ON FINAL RESTROOM LOCATION.
- 6. COMMERCIAL KITCHEN CODE RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO COMMERCIAL KITCHEN DESIGN.
- 7. MANDATORY FIRE COMMAND CENTER AT THIS LOCATION.
- 8. COMMERCIAL RESTROOM CODE AND ADA ACCESSIBLE RESTROOM CODE RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO RESTAURANT RESTROOM DESIGN.
- 9. IN KITCHEN DINING CODE RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO PLACEMENT AND

DESIGN OF CHEFS TABLE DINING ELEMENT.

- 10. SECONDARY KITCHEN ENTRANCE, POSSIBLY DESIGNATED FOR DELIVERIES
- 11. LOCATION OF CURRENT BAR PLUMBING. RELOCATION MAY BE REQUIRED DEPENDING ON FINAL BAR LOCATION.
- 12. POSSIBLE LOCATION OF ADA RAMP CONNECTING LOBBY LEVEL TO RESTAURANT LEVEL. FURTHER RESEARCH REQUIRED.
- 13. POSSIBLE LOCATION OF NEW ENTRY TO RESTAURANT FROM HOTEL LOBBY.
- 14. HISTORIC PRESERVATION CODE RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO DESIGN OF THE RESTAURANT AND CAFE AREAS.
- 15. MAIN ENTRANCE TO RESTAURANT AREA FROM STREET.
- 16. LOCATION OF REDESIGNED VESTIBULE. VESTIBULE CODE RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO PRESENTING ALTERNATIVE DESIGN OPTIONS.
- 17. CURRENT ENTRANCES INTO HOTEL, CAFE AND RESTAURANT AREA.
- 18. FURTHER OCCUPANCY CODE ANALYSIS REQUIRED TO DETERMINE CAFE OCCUPANCY CODE.
- 19. LOCATION OF NON-STRUCTURAL CONCRETE COLUMN. COLUMN CAN BE REMOVED IF REQUIRED.
- 20. LOCATION OF POSSIBLE ADA RAMP CONNECTING BOTH FLOOR LEVELS IN CAFE AREA. FURTHER RESEARCH REQUIRED PRIOR TO RAMP DESIGN AND PLACEMENT.
