PRO AG COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

Pro Ag of Renville County will award up to 2 or more \$250 to \$500 scholarships for each school listed to graduating high school students enrolled at an institution of higher education. Preference may be given to applicants pursuing an education in agriculture or related field.

ProAg of Renville County may also award \$500 and /or \$1000 scholarship(s) available to all applicants who attend a qualifying school who are enrolled at an institution of higher education. Preference may be given to applicants pursuing an education in agriculture or related field.

Students who are Renville County residents and attend other schools are also eligible for these scholarships
Possess a GPA of 2.5 or better.

Selection is based on academic aptitude, vocational promise, personal attributes and leadership qualities.

This scholarship is made available through ProAg of Renville County with funding from the Renville County All Ag Celebration and other contributors.

JONATHAN ROKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To continue the spirit of Jonathan Roker, the Jonathan Roker Memorial Scholarship was originally provided and funded by the Bird Island – Lake Lillian Class of 1979 and is now administered by ProAg. QUALIFICATIONS

Pro Ag of Renville County will award 1 or more \$1,000 scholarship(s) to a student of the listed graduating high school who is enrolled at an institution of higher education. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing an education in agriculture, crop or livestock or related ag field.

Possess a GPA of 2.0 or better.

Selection is based on academic aptitude, vocational promise, personal attributes and leadership qualities.

Added consideration will be given for student who demonstrates activities in 4-H.

Added consideration will be given for student who demonstrates activities in FFA.

Added consideration will be given for student who demonstrates other leadership activities.

A scoring model will be used to determine candidates qualifications.
