6:30 p.m. Brauhaus, Lucan. What could be more logical than Supper at the Brauhaus in little Lucan, population about 240 when everyone is home. Buffet meal of chicken breast or BBQ pork chops, vegetable medley, cheesy potato, snicker salad, bread and lemonade (adult beverages are on own and not part of the tour costs). And once you sip their beer it might be logical to purchase the product to take home.
