

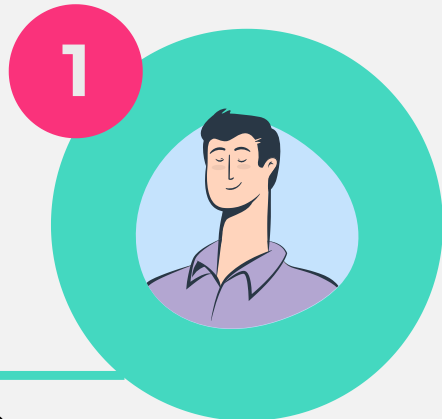
Desktop & Mobile Apps

OAuth 2.0 User-Agent

With the **OAuth 2.0 user-agent flow**, users authorize a desktop or mobile app to access data using an external or embedded browser. Client apps running in a browser using a scripting language such as JavaScript can also use this flow.

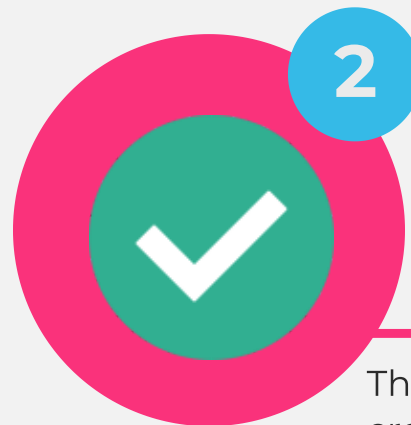
GERARDO OPENS THE MOBILE APP

Internally the connected app redirects the user to the authorization endpoint.



GERARDO NEEDS TO GRANT ACCESS TO THE APP

The user logs into Salesforce with their credentials. The user interacts with the authorization endpoint directly, so the application never sees the user's credentials.



SALESFORCE GRANTS AN ACCESS TOKEN

After a user approves access to a connected app, Salesforce redirects the user to the callback URL.



GERARDO NOW HAS ACCESS TO SALESFORCE RESOURCES THROUGH THE MOBILE APP

Now, the connected app can extract and use to access data on the end user's behalf.
