**Read:** “For I say through the grace that was given me, to every man who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think reasonably, as God has apportioned to each person a measure of faith. <sup>4</sup> For even as we have many members in one body, and all the members don’t have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another,” Romans 12:3-5 (WEB)

**Devotional Thought:**

In this passage, the apostle Paul emphasizes the vital principles of humility and unity within the body of Christ. He urges us not to think of ourselves more highly than we should but to have a balanced view of ourselves, recognizing that our talents and gifts come from God's grace.

The body of Christ is composed of diverse individuals with unique gifts and abilities. No member is more important than another, and all are necessary for the body to function harmoniously. **Read:** “not lagging in diligence; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; <sup>12</sup> rejoicing in hope; enduring in troubles; continuing steadfastly in prayer; <sup>13</sup> contributing to the needs of the saints; given to hospitality. <sup>14</sup> Bless those who persecute you; bless, and don’t curse.” Romans 12:11-14 (WEB)

**Devotional Thought:**

In these verses, Paul encourages us never to lack zeal in our spiritual journey. Our faith should not be stagnant or lukewarm but vibrant and fervent. A key aspect of this fervent spirit is being joyful in hope, even in the midst of afflictions. Our hope is anchored in the promises of God, who is faithful and true.

**Pray:**

## DAY

## 6

## REJOICING AND WEEPING TOGETHER

**Read:** “Rejoice with those who rejoice. Weep with those who weep. <sup>16</sup> Be of the same mind one toward another. Don’t set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Don’t be wise in your own conceits.” Romans 12:15-16 (WEB)

**Devotional Thought:**

In these verses, the apostle Paul highlights the importance of empathy, humility, and unity within the body of Christ. He urges us to rejoice with those who experience joy and to mourn with those who face sorrow, fostering a community of compassion and care.

Living in harmony with one another involves fostering an atmosphere of unity, respect, and cooperation. If he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in doing so, you will heap coals of fire on his head.”

<sup>21</sup> Don’t be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

### Devotional Thought:

In these powerful verses, the apostle Paul presents a profound perspective on responding to evil. Rather than seeking revenge or returning evil for evil, Paul urges us to overcome evil with good, guided by the principles of love and compassion.

It is important to note that choosing not to take revenge does not mean condoning or excusing wrongdoing. Leaving room for God’s justice means entrusting the situation to God, knowing that He sees all and will ultimately bring about justice in His perfect timing.

Paul goes further, encouraging us to extend kindness and care even to our enemies. The act of feeding and providing for those who may have wronged us challenges our natural instincts but aligns with Christ’s teachings to love our enemies and pray for those who persecute us (Matthew 5:44).

By overcoming evil with good, we break the cycle of hatred and animosity. Acts of kindness and compassion can soften hearts, leading to reconciliation and healing. It is a transformative approach that demonstrates the power of God’s love to change hearts and bring about restoration.

### Pray

Pray about responding to evil with goodness and forgiveness. Seek the divine’s strength to overcome evil with love and kindness, even in the face of adversity. Pray for the grace to be peacemakers and to leave judgment to God.
