SPECTATOR POLICY - SQJBC

GOLD COAST SPORTS AND LEISURE CENTRE

- All spectators may enter the stadium, **15 minutes** prior to their allocated game time.
- Spectators that enter earlier will be denied entry to their game altogether
- Spectators **MUST** scan in when entering the building and display their confirmation page at the entrance
- Courts 2 and 3 spectators must view the game from upstairs only, courts 1 and 4 must be against the glass windows at all times.
- Spectators must maintain social distancing at all times (1 person per 2 square metres) as per State Government regulations.
- If asked to move upstairs for social distancing purposes by the court controller, please² do so. Failure to comply will see spectators removed from the stadium.

ENTRANCE PROCEDURE: SQJBC GOLD COAST SPORTS AND LEISURE CENTRE

- Entry into the GCSLC is via the stairs at the Northern Entrance of the stadium.
- Teams and Spectators please do not enter the stadium prior to 15 minutes before your allocated game.
- Coaches, managers, score table officials and spectators must sign in using the QR Code upon entry and display the confirmation page to Gold Coast City Council Security Officer
- Players and referees do not have to scan in.
- Sanitisation products are provided on entrance to the stadium
- Players to have showered prior to entering the stadium
- Players must be dressed in their playing uniform, with basketball shoes on ready to play upon entry into the stadium

GAME DAY PROCEDURES: BQJBC COVID-19 ATTENDANCE REGISTER REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the Covid-19: Return to Play Guidelines, we are required to register attendance details for all individuals who enter the stadium on game day

Please follow the instructions detailed below:

Note: all players will be registered through the courtside app, they do NOT need to submit a QR code scan

Check-in process:

- Scan QR Code - using the camera on your phone or a QR Reader at the entrance.
- Fill in the required details - First name, surname, phone number, address, add additional children if necessary
- Select check boxes to confirm health questions and compliance of guidelines
- Select 'submit'
- Have the confirmation page open and show to GCCC security upon entry

GAME PROCEDURES: SQJBC

- Gold Coast Basketball to provide 1 x Game ball (teams to provide their own warm up balls)
- Each team must provide 2 x score table officials
- Coaches to check in players to courtside upon arrival to the court
- Bench seating for teams, coach, manager (maximum of 4 team officials only and must be dressed in their association polo and closed in shoes) as per BQ requirements
- Water Eskys are permitted for teams - the tap for refilling is downstairs in the carpark area, there is no facility to fill water eskys in the gym (however there are water fountains for bottles).
- At the completion of the game, all players and officials must collect their equipment quickly and exit the team bench area immediately
- Team reviews can be conducted downstairs outside the stadium.

POST GAME PROCEDURES: SQJBC

- Bio Safety Officer (Court Controller) Referee Co-Ordinator and referees to commence sanitisation of Basketballs / iPad / Score bench / Chairs for Score bench / bench for players
- Immediate exit of Players, Head Coach, Manager, Score bench and spectators from the team bench area
- Referees to complete sanitisation of court they are on and stay or move to allocated court for next game immediately
- Signage and sanitisation products on exit of stadium
- Players to shower immediately once they have returned home
