Individuals **MUST NOT** attend basketball activities if they:

- Are feeling unwell and suffering from cold or flu-like symptoms
- Have tested positive for COVID-19 or have come in contact with a known or suspected COVID-19 case within the last 14 days
- Are a high health risk (due to age or pre-existing conditions)
- Have travelled to a COVID declared hotspot

Management of Unwell Participants & any Potential Outbreak

In the event that there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 Moreton Bay Basketball will follow all directions from Queensland Health. The course of action dictated by Queensland Health is impossible to determine, but it may require the stadium to be cleaned or, in an extreme case, the rest of the tournament may have to be cancelled.

Venue Entry Point

Separate entry and exit points have been designated at the main entrance to the stadium. Please adhere to the signs and follow instructions.

Spectators are required to sanitise hands on entry and wipes will be provided to sanitise each basketball.

There is a maximum of 40 people in the foyer of the building at one time. Officials will be monitoring this carefully.

All teams must leave the venue immediately after their game has been played. Team meetings must be held outside.

Visitor Tracing

All spectators must sign in via the QR code or register required. **Only ONE spectator per player** is permitted to enter the stadium due to the COVID 19 restrictions in place.

Team Entry

Players are to arrive to the stadium in uniform & ready to play.

Team water coolers are not allowed & drinking fountains are not available at the stadium.

A Moreton Bay Basketball Official will collect the teams from the designated court marshalling areas outside the stadium. Teams will only be allowed to enter once previous game has finished and the bench has been sanitised.

All coaching staff and spectators must sign in & sign out using the QR Code available.

All persons in-and-out of the stadium will be monitored and all people will be required to show they have checked in upon entry into the stadium.

Social distancing requirements of 1.5 metres are to be maintained.
