STAGE 3 RESTRICTIONS

Northside Wizards Basketball COVID Safe Plan is for SQJBC competitions resuming in term 4 following the Corona Virus Pandemic. The COVID Safe Plan aligns with the Basketball Queensland Queensland Health approved COVID Safe Plan relative to returning to play:

The guiding principles remain:

- Keeping all people who access the venue safe and healthy
- Alignment with state and federal restrictions
- Utilising the regulations and operating principles of Basketball

Northside Wizards Basketball will ensure:

- members are made aware of the Basketball Queensland COVID Safe plan and relevant stage
- maintain a summary of all persons who enter & exit venues used Northside Indoor Sports Centre
- will have a designated Bio Safety Officer who will manage all COVID process and protocols relevant to Queensland Health and Basketball Queensland guidelines.

Game Day Venue – Northside Indoor Sports Centre, 20 Cambewarra St Zillmere

All coaching staff and spectators must sign in & sign out using the QR Code available. If unable to use the QR code, a manual registration will be processed with the bio-security officer at the venue.

Number Management:

- All persons in-and-out of the stadium will be monitored & all people will be required to show they have checked in upon entry into the stadium.
- A two spectator per player rule will be implemented
- Social distancing requirements 1.5 metres maintained. Benches around the courts are limited to 6 people per bench. Any additional spectators that cannot sit on the benches around the court must sit in the grandstand overlooking Court 1 & 2.
- Period of changeover all persons will be required to exit the venue at the completion of each game in a timely & efficient manner.
- Entry into the venue will only be permitted at the relevant session time, approximately 10 minutes prior to tipoff

Hygiene Requirements:

- Hand Sanitiser available on entry and exit at the stadium
- Members and visitors should practice good hygiene including hand washing
- Increased Hygiene Signage has been placed
- Communal tools Balls, iPad, Scoretable to be wiped down before and after every use. Wipes to be placed in the bin provided immediately. Wipes and Sanitiser will be located on each score table
- Members and visitors must not attend if displaying any flu like symptoms
- Players are to arrive to the stadium in unform & ready to play. They should not be getting changed at the venue.
- No sharing of water bottles, towels or uniform/clothing
- Balls to warm up with are allowed
- Water Coolers are not allowed & drinking fountains are not available within the Centre. Players are advised to bring their own individual water bottles and supply.

ARRIVAL:

- Players & coaching staff are to wait in the designated waiting area (left of the main entrance) prior to game times.
- Spectators can wait either in the shaded area at Jabiru Community College opposite the stadium, in the "pick-up zone" in the middle of the car park area or in their car prior to game times.
- Players and parents are to arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before their delegated game time

ROAD SAFETY: Coaches and managers will need to supervise Junior players in the car park area. A speed limit of 20km/h applies in the carparks and throughout the complex

ENTRY:

- Member entry restricted to relevant session time
- Entry will be from the left staircase leading up to the main entrance to the stadium & entering through the left-hand side doors.
- Players & coaching staff will enter stadium first. All spectators will be permitted entry once all teams have entered. Spectators need to show they have checked in using the QR code to enter.

Game Protocol:

Coaches: Unrestricted

Court Supervisors: Unrestricted

Referees: Unrestricted

Score Bench and officials: Unrestricted

Shaking of hands and High Fives: Should be avoided

Parents/Guardians/Spectators: Permitted (2 per player)

Team Manager: Unrestricted

Non-Essential Services:

Changerooms: Closed

Referee room: Open, maximum limits apply

General downstairs standing areas and non-essential areas: Open

Water Fountain: Closed

Food & Drinks will be available for purchase outside the venue from the Pilpel caravan which will be located just outside the exit staircase & ramp to the right of the entrance. Preferred payment method EFTPOS.

EXIT:

- Once game has concluded: Exit will be via the left-hand side (opposite to the entry doors). The entry & exit will be clearly marked & separated.
- Teams will exit accompanied by Parents, Coaches and Managers. Please assist players to safely exit to the carpark area
- Court Supervisor will remain inside to adequately clean equipment (Score bench, iPad, Balls, Bench Chairs) in between games. Referee Coordinator will assist Court Supervisor with cleaning
- Bio-security officer will return to front door to allow access for next designated session group
