RETURN TO BASKETBALL GUIDELINES

COVID-19 RECOVERY

General competition is classified as 5 on 5, 3 on 3, Domestic and Rep Competitions of all age groups, both indoor and outdoor. General competition guidelines are relevant when the general participant attends a stadium for the purpose of playing in a single game. Members may need to consider which types of competitions or age groups are suitable during different reactivation levels. Teams may only enter the stadium at the scheduled time of their competition and must immediately leave the court and stadium when their competition has been completed. A head count must be made by the Biosafety Officials (BO) prior to each game commencing.

Important information for Parents / Players

Please ensure you make yourself familiar with the below COVID Safe Restrictions which MUST be adhered too.

- 2 SPECTATOR PER PLAYER - this is due to our government restrictions on numbers. Scores are included in this number.
- Only come to JBS Stadium 10 minutes before your designated training / game time.
- You MUST sign in on arrival. This confirmation must be shown on entry - IF YOU REFUSE TO COMPLETE YOU WILL BE REFUSED ENTRY.
 - **ANDROID USERS**
To use our QR code Check In, Android users WILL have to download a QR Code Reader app if they do not have a newer model phone.

- No individual Basketballs allowed for games, only training.
- There are various sanitisation stations located throughout the Arena.
- Main Court spectators MUST sit up in the grand stands - NO courtside seating allowed.
- Main Court spectators will exit out the emergency exit at the end of the grandstand.
- Main Court players, coaches and scorebench will exit from the emergency exit on Court 1, Llewellyn end.
- Court 3 spectators - Team A (which is the first team names on the draw) to sit at the Llewellyn end of the court, Team B the soccer end
- Court 3 spectators, players, coaches and scorebench will exit out the court 4 emergency exit - Llewellyn end.
- Court 4 spectators - Team A to sit at the soccer end of the court, Team B at the Llewellyn end.
- Court 3 spectators, players, coaches and scorebench will exit out the court 4 emergency exit - Llewellyn end.

VENUE INFORMATION

- NO CASH - Only eftpos, canteen will only be opened for drinks and packaged food - no cooked food.
- The front car park will not be available for parking as it will be an overflow for spectators to gathering while social distancing.
- Ensure you are on time as the front doors will close once games commence.

FIXTURE INFORMATION

- 10 minute quarters
- 2 minute half time
- No stopping of the clock during time outs except in the last two minutes of the 4th Qtr
- No High fives or Hugging
- Team Managers, please have your player singlet numbers ready to enter into Court side on entry. This will avoid a hold up of play.
