# COVID-19 GUIDELINES AND RESOURCES

Sunshine Coast Basketball Association (SCBA) COVID Safe Plan is for SQJBC competitions resuming in 2021 following the Corona Virus Pandemic. The COVID Safe Plan aligns with the Basketball Queensland-Queensland Health approved COVID Safe Plan relative to returning to play.

- If you are unwell or feel you are starting to get flu-like symptoms – STAY AT HOME – Get Tested.
- Keep distance when entering, exiting and while in the stadiums.
- Avoid touching surfaces; do not touch anything that does not belong to you.
  - Sanitise and wash your hands regularly
- If you test positive within 14 days of being at Sunshine Coast Basketball, notify the Association immediately.



# ARRIVAL AND ENTRANCE PROCEDURE: COMPETITONS



- Parent/guardians able to enter through main front doors at stadium and will need to sign in through QR Code at Entrance
- Players and spectators are to wait until being asked to enter the venue. Member entry restricted to relevant game time
- Players and parents are to arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before their delegated arrival time
- Court 3 will enter first at the delegated time slot, Court 2 will follow then Court 1
- **ROAD SAFETY:** Coaches and managers will need to supervise Junior players in the car park area.

# 2021 SQJBC COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Attendance to Stadium	Must use QR Code on Entry
Basketballs in the Stadium	Allowed - MUST BE SANITISED UPON ENTRY
Basketball Cleaning between games	In line with Guidelines
Canteen	Operating - Eftpos payment preferred
Changerooms and Toilets	Open and Cleaned Dailey
Court Cleaning	Daily
Court/Referee Supervisor	As per competition rule
COVID-19 Health Signage	Mandatory
Designated Entry and Exit Points	Displayed
General Seating	1 per 2 square meters
Hand Sanitiser	Mandatory and available thought-out stadium
Participant Arrival and Departure Time	Max 10 minutes prior to game and immediate departure post game to allow for next teams
Public Water Fountains and Water Coolers	Open and Allowed
Referees and Changerooms	As per competition rule
Shaking of hands/high fives	Should be avoided but not mandatory
Social Distancing	As per Govt regulations – 1.5m
Spectators/Parents/Guardians	2 SPECTATORS PER PLAYER

## **Exit:**

Once game has concluded: Exit will be via the Side door via the toilets. Court 2 and 3 will have access to exit via the fire door.

- Teams will exit accompanied by Parents, Coaches and Managers
- Bio Safety officer will remain inside to adequately clean equipment (Score bench, iPad, Balls, Bench Chairs) in between games. Referee Coordinator will assist Bio Safety Officer with cleaning

Venue Co-Ordinator will return to front door to allow access for next designated session group
