

Under 8 (U8) Mixed Competition Rules

These rules are designed to ensure the Under 8 (U8) Mixed Competition provides a safe, inclusive, and development-focused environment that supports players in learning the fundamentals of basketball in a positive and enjoyable setting.

1. Competition Structure

- 1. Each team shall have **four (4) players** on the court at any one time.
- 2. To avoid a forfeit, a team must have a **minimum of three (3) players** available to take the court.
- 3. Each team must have a **minimum of six (6) registered players** to be eligible to nominate for the competition.
- 4. Mixed teams are permitted.

2. Equipment and Court Specifications

- 1. A size 5 basketball shall be used.
- 2. The ring height shall be 2.44 metres (8 feet) from the floor.
- 3. Games shall be played on the standard half or full court as determined by the draw and court availability.

3. Game Timing

- 1. Games shall consist of four (4) quarters of ten (10) minutes each.
- 2. Each team is permitted **two (2) timeouts** in the first half and **three (3) timeouts** in the second half.
- 3. There shall be a **one** (1) **minute break** between quarters and a **two** (2) **minute break** at half time.
- 4. The game clock will stop only for timeouts.

4. Rules of Play

- 1. The backcourt rule does not apply.
- 2. **Personal fouls** shall be recorded; however, no player will be disqualified for personal fouls.
 - o If a player is fouling excessively or in a manner deemed unsafe, the player may be substituted following consultation between coaches.

- 3. **Defence is not permitted before halfway.** Players must retreat to their half following a basket or stoppage before defending.
- 4. Scores shall not be displayed or recorded.
- 5. **No finals** are to be played in this competition, as it is a learning-based program.
- 6. All participating players shall receive an **IBA participation trophy** at the conclusion of the season.

5. Coaching and Officiating

- 1. Each coach is required to **referee to the best of their ability** for the duration of the game, ensuring fairness to both teams.
 - o There must always be **two (2) coach-referees (with whistles)** on the court during play.
- 2. Coaches are encouraged to **enter the court to support players** when necessary, including assisting with positioning during play or at free throws.
- 3. Only the **coach, assistant coach, and team manager** are permitted on the team bench.
 - o In exceptional cases of high-level player need, a responsible parent or guardian may sit on the bench to support the child.

6. Coach-Referee Guidelines

The U8 Mixed Competition is a **learning league**. Coaches act as referees to help players understand the game and develop their skills in a supportive environment.

- 1. **Leniency** should be applied to minor infringements to maintain game flow and player enjoyment.
- 2. Excessive travelling or double dribbling should be called, explained briefly to the player, and result in a change of possession.
- 3. All personal fouls should be called to ensure player safety.
- 4. When a player oversteps on an inbound pass, the ball should be returned to them to attempt again correctly.
- 5. Coaches should take brief opportunities to explain decisions where appropriate to support learning.

7. Conduct and Compliance

All coaches, referees, managers, players, and spectators must adhere to the:

- IBA Code of Conduct, and
- **Zero Tolerance Policy**, as published on the Ipswich Basketball Association website.



8. Purpose

The U8 Mixed Competition is a **participation and learning-focused league** aimed at introducing players to the sport of basketball in a fun, inclusive, and supportive environment. The emphasis is on enjoyment, teamwork, and skill development — not on winning or results.
