We believe in identifying with others who share a common faith and vision.

We believe in a fellowship of ministers dedicated to nurturing relationships and strengthening bonds of love between each other and not to control or usurp Local Church Autonomy.

We believe that as ministers we should uphold the highest moral and ethical values taught in the Bible in order to be effective around the world for Jesus Christ through a strong Local Church.

We believe in being available to sincerely share our personal and ministerial lives in order to strengthen and edify relationships among member-ministries.

We believe in providing balance for one another, the impartation of new spiritual truth and strengthening of existing truths that are a blessing to the member-ministries.

We believe in the offer of enrichment, teaching, counsel, and fellowship with fellow member-ministries and ministers around the world

Harvest International Ministerial Fellowship FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF ETHICAL CONDUCT FOR CLERGY

THE PURPOSE FOR FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF ETHICAL CONDUCT FOR CLERGY: The public generally expects clergy to practice certain personal and professional ministerial ethical conduct. These guidelines are for clergy and other church professionals who wish to be a part of Harvest

These guidelines do not presume to speak to all areas of ministers' lives. These ethical principles articulate minimum expectations of Holy Scripture, personal conscience, counsel and Christian tradition of the clergy. The clergy shall always practice moral purity as guided by Holy Scripture, civil law, honesty and integrity of conduct. This Code of Ethical Conduct set forth essential *Fundamental Principles of Ethical Conduct For Clergy* that must be accepted by all those who wish to hold credentials in Harvest Internationals Ministerial Fellowship.

I will conduct my life in a manner that is faithful to the gospel and consistent with the *Fundamental Principles of Ethical Conduct For Clergy* in my public ministry and private life. Therefore, I will:

- 1) I hereby profess before God and man that I myself am a Christian, having received Jesus Christ by faith as my Savior,
- 2) I believe in one true God and Jesus Christ as Savior, I acknowledge Him Lord of all and Head of the Church, and to and the Holy Spirit
- 3) Be obedient to Christ, under the authority of Scripture.

- 4) Practice the disciplines of study, prayer, reflection, worship, stewardship and service.
- **5)** Be honest and truthful in my relationships with others.
- 6) Be faithful, keeping the covenants I make and honoring marriage vows;
- 7) Treat all persons with equal respect and concern as beloved children of God:
- 8) I affirm holy matrimony between one man and one woman as the only appropriate union for sexual intimacy, and to model this affirmation in my own lives.
- 9) I understand that any person who has a civil or criminal record of child abuse, who has admitted prior sexual abuse or is known to have a pedophiliac diagnosis (e.g. pedophilia, exhibitionism, voyeurism) as defined by the American Psychiatric Association is prohibited from any interaction with children and youth.

- 10) In all professional matters, ministers are to maintain practices that give glory to Christ; advance the goals of the Church; and nurture, challenge and protect the welfare of church members, parishioners, clients and the public.
- 11) Ministers are to act in such a manner as to uphold and enhance the honor, integrity, morality and dignity of the profession.
- Ministers are to limit their ministries to those positions and responsibilities for which they are qualified.
- 13) Ministers will conduct all professional matters in a manner, which assures confidentiality and avoids conflicts of interest.
- 14) Ministers will seek to maintain professional competency throughout their careers.
- 15) In personal as well as professional relationships ministers are to demonstrate honest and sincere motives evidencing respect, honesty and fairness; uphold the peace, unity and purity of the church; and share faith, hope and love with all people.
- 16) The minister shall him/herself obey the civil law and insist leaders and members of his/her congregation do likewise. This includes, but is not limited to, matters related to taxes, the keeping of records
- 17) There may be times when the minister affirms the necessity of civil disobedience for moral reasons. Whether this is done alone or in conjunction with others (including officers and members of the congregation), it shall be done openly and with a willingness to accept the consequences of the law. However, in such cases no moral justification for violence against another person or property is acceptable.
- 18) Sexual abuse of or misconduct with a congregational member shall be understood as strictly forbidden. The professional has the responsibility to set the boundaries and to maintain them.
