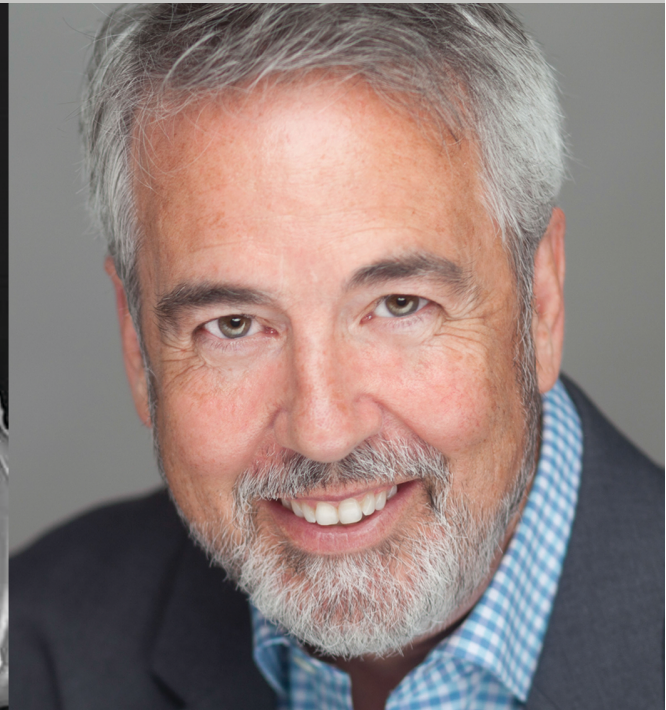
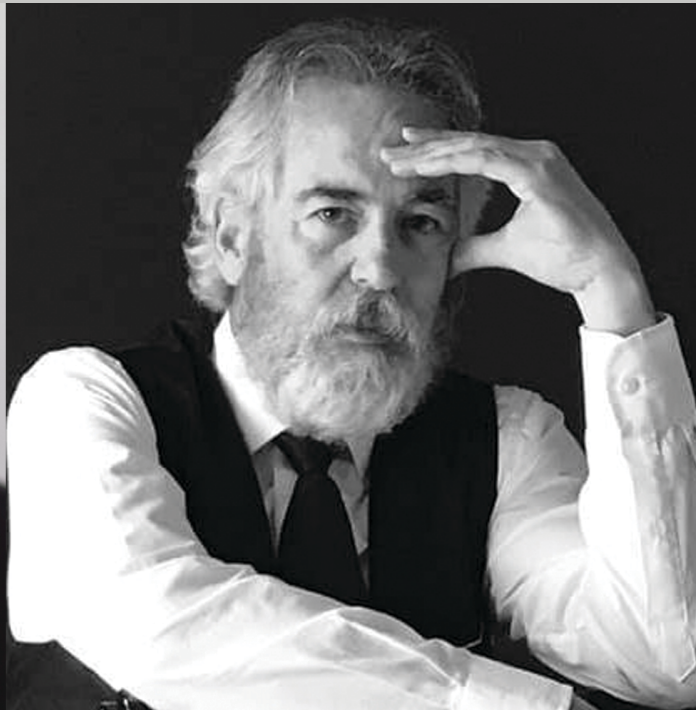
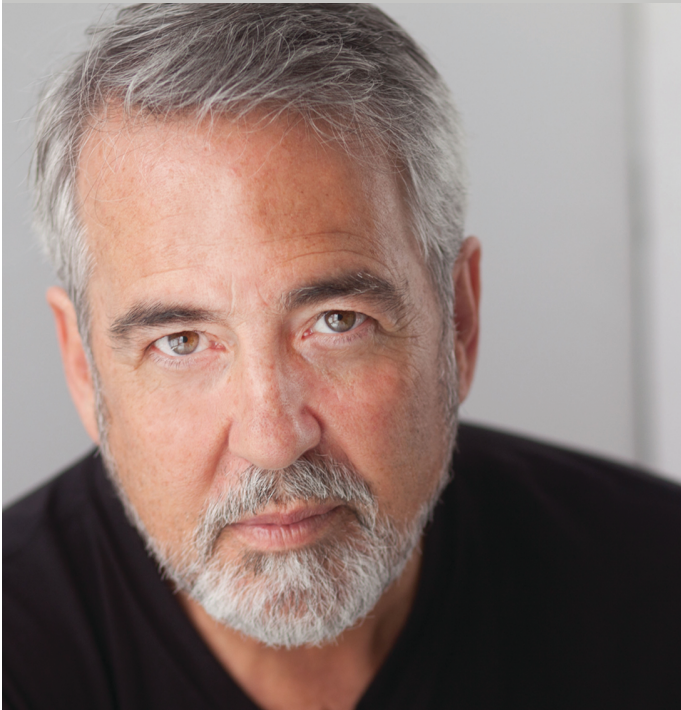
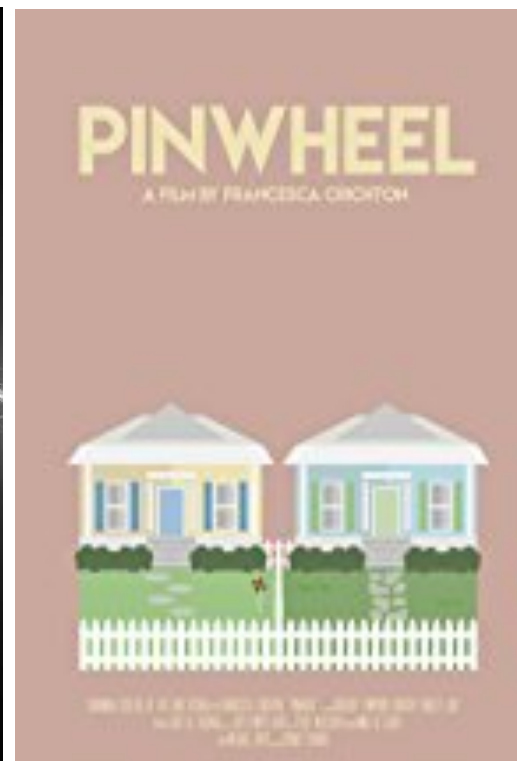
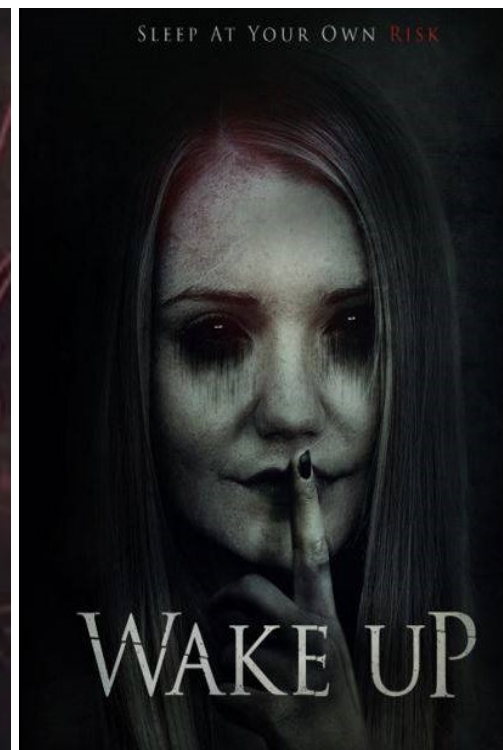


Gregory Dean Tompkins brings a mature easy-going confidence to characters that can be more intense than what may appear on the surface.

AUGUST 2018

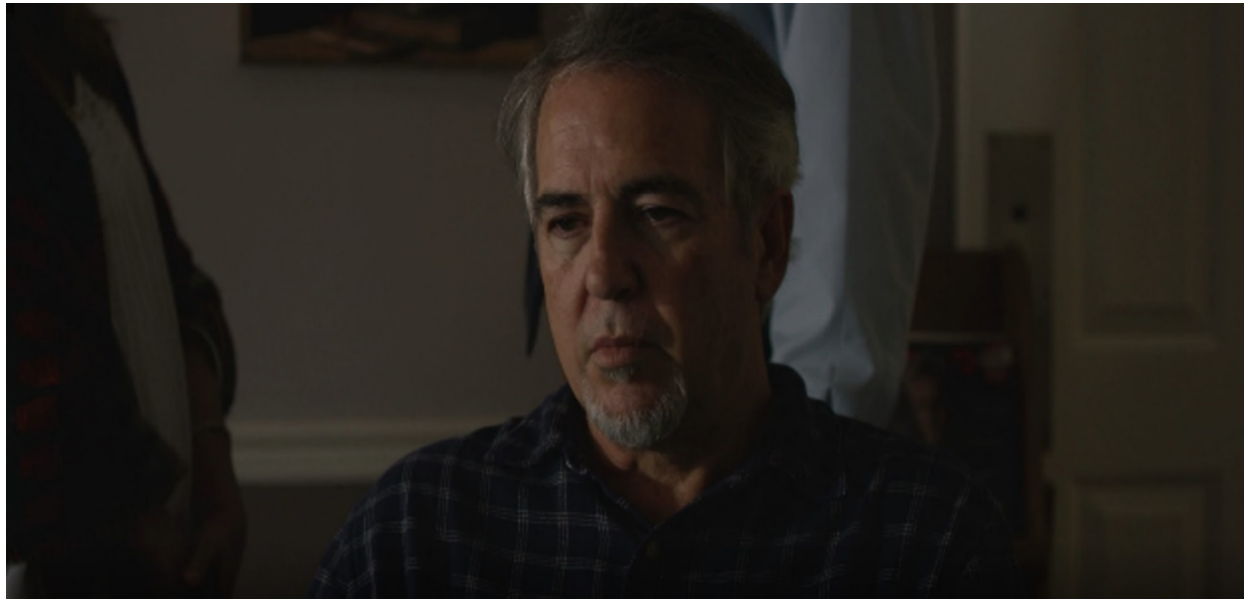
Gregory completes training at The Barrow Group. Auditions for and is cast as Reverend Parris in The Crucible.
