Only students can shop during the daytime hours; no parents/guardians are allowed. Students will shop with their class or cohort during specific hours of the day. Only one class will shop the Book Fair at a time. Watch for communication from your teacher about your student's shopping day.

# **Making it Easy**

#### 1. Setup an e-Wallet to give your student a secure, cash-free way to shop the fair.

Create a free account, preauthorize a spending limit, and have money immediately available for your student to use at the Book Fair. Share your e-Wallet link with family and friends if they would like to add money to your student's account.

\*\*IMPORTANT e-Wallet CHANGE: In years past, the balance left on an e-Wallet account would be refunded back to the credit/debit card used to set up the account. That has changed this year. Any money left on the account will now convert into an e-Gift Card for the Scholastic Store or for future Book Fairs.

**2. Shop Online Beginning – Friday, April 16**<sup>th</sup>- **April 29**<sup>th</sup>. Visit the <u>SWES Scholastic Store</u>. Click "Shop the Virtual Fair". All items will ship to your home. Orders over \$25 ship free.
