The Jackpot Bloody Mary and Beans, Chicken, Pork Ribs and Brisket contests will be held on Saturday, June 28th.

The Lee County Go Texan Committee has added this Go Texan Weekend Event to raise scholarship funds to be given to our Lee County, Texas High School Seniors! In 30+ years, the committee has awarded approximately \$1 Million in scholarships to seniors in the Dime Box, Giddings and Lexington School Districts who continue their education.

To qualify for HLSR head cook MUST be from Lee County

1. BBQ CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

Applications will be accepted up to 5PM on until Friday, June 27, 2025.

- 1.1 Spaces of **40' x 40'** maximum will be assigned on a first-received basis, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 1.2 Pits and RV's may arrive starting Thursday, June 26, 2025, at Noon.
- 1.3 There is a minimum of 3 meats per space. All meat categories must be entered to qualify for HLSR.
- 1.4 No vehicles allowed to be parked in your cooking area. Vehicles may deliver items to your cooking location, however, they will need to be parked in the designated parking location. All vehicles must be parked in designated area after meat check in on Friday.
- 1.5 RVs allowed and must fit inside your 40'x 40' area. NO EXCEPTIONS. No electric or water hookups provided. Generators are allowed.
- 1.6 Contestants will not be allowed to sell any barbecue. Barbecue cooks may give barbecue to spectators if they wish.
- 1.7 **Please observe state liquor laws.** You may bring alcohol to your cook area, designated parking lot in front of the venue. **Alcohol may be present at your cooking site; however, it may not be brought into** the Silos on 77 nor taken to the back area of The Silos on 77 due to our sanctioned TABC Liquor License. The Silos will have beer, wine and liquor available for purchase, as well as Ice. The **CHIEF COOK** will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
- 1.8 Amplification should be used in moderation during the entire cook-off and must be turned off from midnight until 8:00AM. All bands and DJs in the cooking area must be pre-approved. This rule will be strictly enforced and refusal to abide will result in immediate disqualification and eviction from the grounds.
- 1.9 Animals are NOT permitted on the grounds. Service animals ONLY are permitted. No skateboards, tricycles, bicycles, motorcycles, mopeds, golf carts, three-wheelers or four-wheelers will be permitted on grounds.
- 1.10 Committee members reserve the right to make additional regulations as a situation warrant. Decisions of the committee and judges will be final.

- 1.11 Contestants are welcome and encouraged to remain on the grounds after the competition and through Saturday night. A deadline for cleaning the grounds by noon (12PM) on Sun.
- 1.12 It is suggested that you bring suitable shelter as the weather may require. **RAIN OR SHINE the contest will go on.**
- 1.13 The Lee County Go Texan Committee and The Silos on 77, **WILL NOT** be liable for theft or damages.

2. **BBQ CONTEST - COOKING**

- 2.1 Chief cook or a representative **MUST** be present at Chief Cook's meeting Friday afternoon at 5PM inside Silos on 77; failure to appear will be reason for disqualification from contest.
- 2.2 Chief cook will need ID **if** competing to represent Lee Co @HLSR BBQ contest.
- 2.3 The meat from which entries are to be taken will not be allowed on grills before meat is inspected or tagged. Beans and Meat will be inspected by the Committee from **2:00PM to 6:00PM Friday.**
- 2.4 **PRE-COOKED, SALTED, SEASONED OR MARINATED MEAT or BEANS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
- 2.5 Each contestant may cook two separate pieces of the type of meat it submits as its entry (e.g., two slabs of ribs, two chickens, two briskets). If a contestant elects to cook two pieces of meat, both pieces must be inspected.
- 2.6 Contestants must supply all the equipment and supplies needed. No electric cookers will be allowed. Propane or butane cookers are not allowed. All fires must be in containers not on the ground. Holes, dug pits or open flames in boxes or other containers resting on or less than two feet above the ground surface are not permitted. **OPEN FLAMES OF ANY KIND ARE NOT PERMITTED** (e.g., tiki torches or campfires.)
- 2.7 Each team will be responsible for cleaning up their space. Hot coals and ashes should be disposed of (not on the ground or in regular trash cans.)

Brisket	3:00 PM	Container Provided: 7 slices no thicker than #2 pencil

<p>Note: Foil Squares will be provided for containers and only placed at the bottom of the container. Lids will be provided for cups. No other decorations or garnishes will be allowed.</p> <p>ENTRIES MUST BE TURNED IN AT DESIGNATED TURN IN TIME, PER CATEGORY. TEN MINUTE GRACE PERIOD IS ALOTTED. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH TURN IN TIMES WILL RESULT IN A NON-ENTRY FOR THE TEAM.</p>		

***Meat containers will be handed out at Chief Cook Meeting; Also Jackpot and Open containers will be available for purchase.**

A. MARGARITA & BLOODY MARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Participants must be at least 21 years or older.
- Margaritas should be tequila based. Bloody Mary must be Vodka based. May use pre-mixes and regular spices.
- No ice in supplied containers for judging.
- Points awarded for originality only. No points for presentation. No miscellaneous items are allowed on top of cup. (ie. Twizzlers, Umbrellas etc.)
- Garnishes must fit inside containers with the lid closed.

B. OPEN EVENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries are at the discretion of the registered team.
- Entry may be any meat and/or vegetable dish cooked on a pit or grill.
- NO Desserts or Breads Allowed.
- Jackpot Open placement does not apply to Master Cook or Lee County Team Points

C. JACK POT BEANS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries must start as Dry Beans, inspected on Friday.
- Beans may be soaked
- No Can Beans allowed
- Entries will be judged on taste, aroma and consistency

- Nothing larger than the bean can be placed in the turn-in container. You may cook with meat, vegetables and desired seasonings; however they must be the same size or smaller than bean.
- Each entry will receive a cup furnished by the Bean Committee for turn in. Everyone turning in beans is responsible for their ticket from the turn in container, failure to do so will result in disqualification of entry.
- Jackpot placings do not apply to Master Cook or Lee County Team Points

D. MEAT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Meat to be inspected on Friday
- No meat to be pre-seasoned and must be cooked onsite.
- All fires for BBQ must be wood or wood substance.
- Each team cooks meats on their own pit.
- Chicken: Must turn in 1 half uncut chicken
- Ribs: Must turn in 7 individually cut ribs (Baby Back Ribs not allowed)
- Brisket: Must turn in 7 slices of brisket, not thicker than a #2 pencil.
- See list of Turn in Times under BBQ Contest Rules

E. JUDGING AND AWARDS

- 3.1 Judging for each category will begin 15 minutes after turn in.
- 3.2 Do not tear off the ticket prior to turning in your entry. The Lee County Go Texan Staff will assist with tickets upon turn in.
- 3.3 Awards will be given to the Top 5 Teams in all categories
- 3.4 Certificates will be given to Top Teams placing 6th – 10th in all categories
- 3.5 Chicken, ribs, and brisket will pay out per category.
1st 200.00 2nd 150.00 3rd 100.00
- 3.6 Margaritas, Bloody Mary, Open Event and Beans do NOT count toward overall Master Cook or Lee County Go Texan 2024 Team Points
- 3.7 Margaritas, Bloody Mary, Open Event and Beans will payout
1st 60% of entries 2nd 40% of entries
- 3.8 All final scores will be posted 1 hour after the awards ceremony
- 3.9 **TIE BREAKER:** In the event of a tie in scoring, the BRISKET Score will be the deciding factor.
- 3.10 Two Top Awards will be awarded as follows:
 - 3.10.1 OVERALL, MASTER COOK TEAM
Cash payout of 150.00
 - 3.10.2 2024 LEE COUNTY GO TEXAN QUALIFYING TEAM
 - 3.10.3 Overall awards can be given to the same team, or separate teams, depending on the scoring of events. If the Overall MASTER Team did not indicate they would like to represent Lee County in the 2026 HLSR Cookoff, then the next

highest team that has indicated participating in 2026 HLSR Cookoff will be awarded the Lee County Team for 2026.

- 3.10.4 **The Lee County Go Texan BBQ Contest Over All winner will be determined by the highest total of points in the **Brisket, Pork Ribs, and Chicken categories ONLY!**** Chief Cook for Team representing Lee County MUST LIVE and have a valid address in Lee County, Texas.
- 3.10.5 The Lee County Overall winner may represent Lee County at the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo World Champion BBQ Contest in 2026, depending on eligibility.
