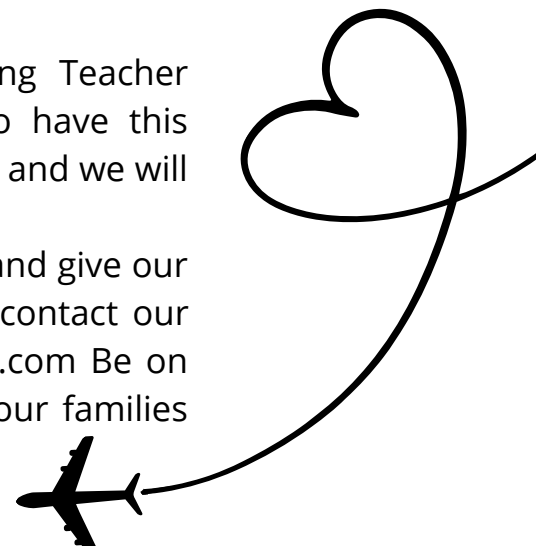
Asian American/Pacific Islander Heritage Month in May

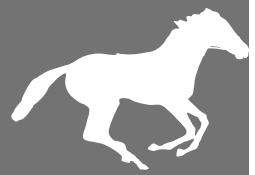
