Given our hot climate, our students need shade during recess and school events. Pioneer families have generously donated over the years to our efforts to raise money to install shade structures. Many parents and school staff have worked on this, and while everyone agrees that this is a priority, various barriers in state law and local policy have prevented these structures from being built. We are working to have BUSD staff visit a meeting with all interested Pioneer parents so that we can collectively work on finding solutions to this problem as soon as possible. We have \$30,000 reserved from previous fundraising for this project and are eager to put it to use.
