Ramadan Mubarak

Ramadan is the ninth month in the Islamic calendar, observed by Muslims worldwide,



and is viewed as a blessed month. Ramadan ends after 29 or 30 days,

depending on the moon. The start of Ramadan depends on the lunar cycle, it starts with the sighting of the Young Moon and ends with a New Moon. Ramadan will come to an end with Eid Al-Fitr, called 'the Festival of Breaking the Fast'. It remembers the month that the Qur'an (the holy book for Muslims) was originally revealed to the Prophet Muhammad. Those observing Ramadan (who are able)

will fast daily from dawn to dusk.
