Filipino American History Month: October is a significant month in Filipino American history because it commemorates the first recorded presence of Filipinos in the United States. According to the Filipino American National Historical Society, Filipinos first arrived in the U.S. aboard a Spanish ship that landed in what is now Morro Bay, California on October 18, 1597. 
This event is an opportunity to connect with other families and to learn from each other.

Fundraising Update

Parents' Club is happy to share that just a few months into the 2022-23 school year, we have already had some successful fundraisers! Our Colts helped raise over \$5,000 in August with our Coin Wars fundraiser. We also had our most successful dine out event in August. So many Pioneer families showed up at Aloha Ice for our Summer Cool Down that they generously donated half of that day's total sales to the Parents' Club, for a donation of \$900! We have several ongoing fundraisers, including spirit wear sales, monthly dine out nights, box tops for education, Amazon Smile, and birthday messages on the marquee.

In addition to these fundraisers, if you were here last year, then you likely remember that with our Raise Craze fundraiser, Pioneer students raised about \$15,000 for Parents' Club with the goal of funding more shade structures at the school. We fell short of our goal, but fortunately the school district has stepped in to take on this expense for us. They have tentatively chosen an area to expand shade by the lunch tables out towards the USA map on the pavement. We will continue to provide updates on the process as they come in. Since Parents' Club no longer needs to fund our expanded shade structures, we have been able to use the money raised through Raise Craze in other ways that benefit Pioneer. So far this year we have replaced classroom first aid kits, funded teacher stipends and provided donations of books and PE equipment. We are also looking forward to offsetting field trip costs with contributions from Parents' Club. We strive to be transparent about Parents' Club finances and to use the funds we raise to respond to the needs in our community. We always welcome any questions, concerns and suggestions!
