Class 1 - 09:00 - Main Arena - Clear Round

Open To All

British Showjumping Tack Rules, Conduct Rules & Welfare Policy apply.

Entry Fee = £5.00

Class 2 - 10:00 - Main Arena - Schools 70cm League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 70cm.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19). In case of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase).

Team and individual points are awarded on the following basis: 1st - 12 points, 2nd - 10 points, 3rd - 8 points, 4th - 6 points, 5th - 4 points, 6th - 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clear. For a team to get double clear points at least 3 team members need to be clear in both rounds of a competition. The 3 highest team scores count.

Qualification period July to June:

Qualifies for British Showjumping National Championships. Numbers to qualify: The top 8 teams and top 10 individuals from the league tables will qualify in up to two consecutive height categories. Riders can qualify as an individual and as part of a team. Qualifications will also pass down the leagues with regards to teams and individuals that have already qualified.

Qualification period October to February:

Qualifies for Winter Championships. Numbers to qualify: All riders with points on the 'Just for Schools' league tables by the end of February will be invited to compete in the Winter Championship classes.

Please always enter with yours and the horse/pony's membership number. To ensure you have these details, team and individual forms need to be filled and sent to British Showjumping before the competition.

Entry Fee = £10.00

Class 3 - Main Arena - Schools 80cm League Class

Schools (Single Phase). Speed 300mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Open to teams and individuals aged between 5 and 19 years old (the years in which the rider turns 5 and 19). In case

of teams, this class cannot run as a Two Phase competition (only Table A7 and Single Phase).

Team and individual points are awarded on the following basis: 1st - 12 points, 2nd - 10 points, 3rd - 8 points, 4th - 6 points, 5th - 4 points, 6th - 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clear. For a team to get double clear points at least 3 team members need to be clear in both rounds of a competition. The 3 highest team scores count.

Qualification period July to June:

Qualifies for British Showjumping National Championships. Numbers to qualify: The top 8 teams and top 10 individuals from the league tables will qualify in up to two consecutive height categories. Riders can qualify as an individual and as part of a team. Qualifications will also pass down the leagues with regards to teams and individuals that have already qualified.

Qualification period October to February:

Qualifies for Winter Championships. Numbers to qualify: All riders with points on the 'Just for Schools' league tables by the end of February will be invited to compete in the Winter Championship classes.

Class 5 - not before 11:00 - Main Arena - Pony Intro 70cm Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 70cm.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £17.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £79.00. Entry Fee = £17.00

Class 6 - not before 11:30 - Main Arena - Stepping Stones 128/138cm Handicap

Rule 414. Table A (2 Round). Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 75cm / 85cm.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

For registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members, ages in accordance with Rules 77.12 & 77.13. This competition is open to all but for qualification purposes, those riders up to the end of the calendar year in which the age of 10 is reached are eligible to enter irrespective of Points achieved. Riders aged 10 years and over on 1 January in the calendar year must not have won a total of 350 Points in the 128cms Section and 700 Points in the 138cms section. 128cms ponies are not permitted to enter the 138cms Section.

Pony Riders who have ever obtained points in the Gold League are not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final. Pony/Rider combinations who have ever obtained points in the Silver and/or Gold League are also not eligible for the Stepping Stones Final.

Once Riders have competed at, or have ever qualified for RIHS or HOYS on any height pony they are no longer eligible to compete in the Final. Once a pony has qualified with any rider for RIHS or HOYS in the current year, then it is not eligible to compete in the final.

Qualifies for: Four double clear rounds to qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships.

Qualifying Period: 1st January-30th June.

Numbers to qualify: Those pony/rider combinations who achieve four double clears (subject to revision) will qualify for the Final.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £17.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £79.00. Entry Fee = £17.00

Class 7 - not before 12:30 - Main Arena - Graham Heath Equestrian (128/138cms) UK Championship Handicap Qualifier

Rule 284. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered ponies not exceeding 128cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2006 and registered ponies not exceeding 138cms, to be ridden by Junior Members born in or after 2004. Pony/Riders are not

eligible to compete in this class before the calendar year of which their eighth birthday is reached.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears

Class 8 - not before 13:30 - Main Arena - Pony British Novice Championship - First Round /80cm Open

Rule 410. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 80cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

British Novice:

For registered ponies in Grade JD and JC that have not won a total of 150 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony British Novice Championship Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Pony British Novice First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony British Novice First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

80cm Open:

For registered ponies to be ridden by Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 15 or more starters this class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £17.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £79.00. Entry Fee = £17.00

Class 9 - not before 14:30 - Main Arena - Pony Discovery -First Round/90cm Open

Rule 408. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Discovery:

For registered ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 300 Points to be ridden by Junior Members, ages as per Rule 77.12/77.13.

Qualifies for: Pony Discovery Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify for: Those ponies which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Pony Discovery First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Discovery Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Ponies in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular Pony Discovery First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open:

For registered ponies, to be ridden by Junior Members.

If combined with an open:

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Ponies may enter one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £25.00, 2nd: £20.00, 3rd: £17.00, 4th: £17.00, Total: £79.00. Entry Fee = £17.00

Class 10 - not before 15:00 - Main Arena - Blue Chip Pony Newcomers/Pony 1.00m Open (both to inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Qualifier)

Rule 406 & 416. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Blue Chip Pony Newcomers is for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/rider Combination.

Ponies may compete in one section only.

Please be advised that depending on entries into the prior class may over run resulting in this class running later than the estimated 'not before' timing.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £20.00, Total: £95.00. Entry Fee = £20.00

Class 11 - not before 16:00 - Main Arena - Junior 1.05m Open

Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.05m.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Please be advised that depending on entries into the prior class may over run resulting in this class running later than the estimated 'not before' timing.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £25.00, 3rd: £20.00, 4th: £20.00, Total: £95.00. Entry Fee = £20.00

Class 12 - not before 17:00 - Main Arena - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Pony Foxhunter First Round is for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round.

The Open Section is open to all. Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination.
