A big thank you goes out to Carm Smith and Kelly Best for their continued dedication and hard work in organizing these annual food drives and fundraisers.

We're also deeply grateful to everyone who donates their time, talents, or treasures to help make these events possible.

The USPS Food Drive was another wonderful success, producing a donation of 1,569 items. A special thank you goes to the postal carriers who took on the challenging task of collecting and delivering the donations, and to all who contributed to this important effort.
