Marion Breidenbach

We are sad to report that Marion has officially retired from Canal Winchester Human Services. He has been with Canal Winchester Human Services since 2011 (employee & volunteer) and will be greatly missed! We decided to ask him a few questions about his volunteering experience here.

What first inspired you to start volunteering with us?

Having retired from Riverside Hospital in 2008 after 36 years, I had the opportunity to begin volunteering for Honor Flight Columbus, Ohio Benefit Bank, the USO, and raising puppies with my wife, Gayle, for Pilot Dogs. I also began volunteering with our local Food Pantry, based out of David's UCC, having been started by our Church's Youth Group some years earlier. From that time forward to 2025, I stayed with the Pantry as it grew through the years to become part of Canal Winchester Human Services.

Looking back, what's been the most rewarding part of your volunteer work?

As a firsthand witness, I had the opportunity to see the growth of the Food Pantry in terms of the numbers of people served, the size of the service area, and the scope of programs offered to so many clients. I enjoyed my experience with the organization so much that I joined the CW Human Services team as a shuttle driver for 10 years, 2011-2021.

Is there a moment or memory that stands out as especially meaningful?

My best memories regarding the Pantry are having had the opportunity to work with other devoted volunteers on the Monday afternoon group and more recently the Late Pantry team, as well as having met so many clients over the years.

What advice would you give to new volunteers just starting out?

My advice to any potential volunteer...Careful, it can be addictive!

What I've appreciated most, however, was the opportunity to serve an organization so true to its mission statement.
