

# Temporary Housing Criteria

Older Adults 60+

## Who This is For

### Referral Process:

All referrals must come through Franklin County Adult Protective Services (APS). APS will review eligibility and coordinate with the housing partner if approved.

### Eligibility Requirements:

To qualify for the Transitional Housing Program, individuals must:

- ✓ Be 60+ years of age or older
- ✓ Be a resident of Franklin County
- ✓ Have a verifiable source of income
- ✓ Be referred through Adult Protective Services (APS)

### Length of Stay:

- ✓ Approved participants may stay up to 90 days at no cost.
- ✓ The 90-day stay is intended to provide temporary stabilization.
- ✓ This program is not a shelter program.

### **\*\* If a participant chooses to remain beyond 90 days\*\***

- ✓ They will be required to pay for continued housing.
- ✓ Ongoing residency is subject to housing partner policies and availability.

### Important Notes:

Placement is based on eligibility review and availability. The program is designed as a temporary bridge to stable housing, not permanent housing. All referrals and case information are handled confidentially.
