FLHA SURVEY 2022

Results & Conclusions

- The survey was conducted the first two weeks of February 2022
- One survey per household was accepted and scored
- 38 households out of 46 completed the survey for an 83% response rate

SURVEY RESULTS

BEACH ACCESS

- Importance to household: Avg 51 (scale 0-100)
- Level of assessment willing to pay: \$0 (9); \$1-\$500 (21); \$500+ (7)
- Willingness to serve on a committee Yes (3), No (22) Maybe (13)

Install Additional Lighting at Front Entrance

- Benefit the household & make neighborhood safer? Avg 44 (scale 0-100)
- Importance of adding lighting? Avg 41 (scale 0-100)
- Level of assessment willing to pay? \$0 (16); Up to \$100 (3); up to \$250 (11); over \$250 (8)
- Willing to serve on a committee Yes (3); No (25); Maybe (10)

Install Cameras at Front Entrance

- Benefit household and make neighborhood safer? Avg 47 (scale 0-100)
- Importance of adding cameras Avg 42 (scale 0-100)
- Level of assessment willing to pay 38 responses; \$0 (21); up to \$250 (9); \$251+ (8)
- Willing to serve on a committee − Yes − 2; No − 27; Maybe − 9

School Bus Shelter

- Benefit to the neighborhood: Avg 48 (scale 0-100)
- Importance to repair Avg 39 (scale 0-100)
- Assessment willing to pay: \$0 (19); up to \$100 (6); up to \$250 (8); \$251+ (3)
- Willing to serve on a committee Yes (5); No (31); Maybe (2)
- 2 said would volunteer to help repair

Annual Meeting & Potluck

- Participate in a neighborhood potluck? Yes (30); No (8)
- Potluck at same time as annual meeting? Yes (19); No (11)
- Keep annual meeting on same schedule (3rd Sat in May)? Same (27); Move (10)
- Moving annual meeting would increase likelihood of attending? No (27); Yes (10)
- Annual meeting in person or via Zoom? In person (8); Zoom (8); Either (22)
- Guest Speaker Topics
 - Home and Neighborhood Security (21)
 - FLHA Covenants (18)
 - Emergency Preparedness (11)
 - Wildlife identification (7)
 - Noxious weed identification (5)
 - Other ideas:
 - Environmental conservatism (reduce toxic sprays; water conservation, etc.) (1)
 - Mole control (1)

- Support creating and maintaining a list of neighborhood resident resources? Yes (34); No (4)
- Willing to be on the list? Yes (25); No (12)
- Various answers given identifying skills and tools available if needed
- Willing to be on a committee to create/maintain list? Yes (6), No (20), Maybe (12)

Neighborhood Skills & Resource Directory

- Would your household find this list useful? Yes (19); No (10); Maybe (8)
- Willing to be on a committee to create/maintain directory? Yes (4); No (23); Maybe (10)

Neighborhood Social Groups

- Interested in participating? Yes (13); No (14); Maybe (11)
- Interest in forming or leading a group? Yes (2); No (28); Maybe (8)
- Ideas Bridge/cards, holiday cookie exchange, wine tasting, kids board games, quilting, book club, cooking/baking club, dinner club, gardening, walking group, cookie exchange, bunco, monthly coffee clutch

Board and ACC

- 23 households have had at least one member serve on the Board and/or ACC in past years
- Willing to serve in the future 16 answered; 22 skipped
 - The only respondents to indicate President, VP, Secretary, or Treasurer currently hold those positions. No new prospects.
 - o Most respondents picked Director (10), ACC Chair (5), and/or ACC member (11)
- Support for filling any position Operations Manual and Job Shadowing/Mentoring

CONCLUSIONS

- **Projects** (beach access, lighting, cameras, bus shelter)
 - No clear mandate to pursue any project surveyed
 - Any member of FLHA interested in pursuing one of the major projects may develop a proposal, work plan, and budget to submit to the Board for consideration.
 - The most interest expressed was for the repairs on the bus shelter (volunteers)

Annual Meeting and Potluck

- o Annual meeting & potluck will continue to be 3rd Saturday in May
- o Even split between in-person and virtual, with most being fine with either
- o There is significant interest in having guest speakers on relevant topics
- Good topic for 2023 annual meeting household emergency preparedness
