"Enoch walked with God; then he was no more, because God took him." (Genesis 5:24)

I'm ready for my annual walk. As you may know, at least once a year your pastor endeavors to make a "pilgrimage." No, not to the Holy Land. (Well, close.) The object of my quest is actually New Baltimore Ice Cream! When the weather is right, I set out from the parsonage with the goal of walking the eight miles to New Baltimore and rewarding myself with an ice cream cone at journey's end.

I have a few rules. I carry a staff because I've found that the biggest danger I face is unfriendly dogs. I bring some water and snacks in case I get fatigued (I am getting older!) I choose a slightly different route each year. I wear a hat and comfortable shoes. Tragically, I've learned to go before Closing Day. And I keep my eyes and ears open to things that God may be showing me on my walk.

That last point is especially important. I try to glean spiritual insights on my hike. In past years, I've observed the haphazard flights of monarchs making their way across our region and realized anew how God cares for all His creatures. I've photographed wildflowers that grow among gutters and weeds and recalled Jesus' words about how they compare to Solomon's glory. I often think about our church and our community and how we can best share the love of God with our neighbors. I pray and talk with God and strive to listen.

I wish I could say that it was my constant habit to be on the lookout for what God is saying to me. But I am still at that point in my spiritual journey where I have to intentionally prod myself to do it. I think that "walking with God" is one of the best goals to have in this life. The mysterious Enoch became so close to God through his walking that he apparently didn't face death. God simply "took" him.

And by the way – I only walk one way. Debbie has always been nice enough to pick me up and take me back home!

Building and Grounds Committee: Parsonage front stoop and back bilco area are almost finished; gutters/gutter guards, hand railings, patio privacy fence to be updated; lid to septic tank replaced; still water issues around the church's west wall foundation – excavating may take place to make repairs; Mt. Union incoming freshmen need volunteer hours and we will have outside work for several; Fall work day is set for Saturday, October 12 at 8am. 2.) Outreach Committee is looking for individuals to join their team as Richard and Janice Berube have stepped down at this time; the August 31st breakfast has been cancelled.

OLD BUSINESS: 1.) Updated job descriptions for Children's Ministry Director and Youth Ministry Director have been established with a new combined position for Family Ministry Director in which the Consistory will move forward with, hoping to post the position at Malone University and Mt. Union.

NEW BUSINESS: 1.) A new blood pressure cuff was purchased after the original went missing; a diabetic testing kit will be purchased; an evening session to review the AED & choking devise may be scheduled this fall.


