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**1. Meeting called to order** - Chairman Bob Vitas called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

**2. Roll call of members** – Roll call was taken with Steve Seiver, Mark Rothert, Bob Vitas, Jerry Leibovitz, Chief Ramsey, Chief Karzin, Chief Regenwether, and Chief Radosevich present. Absent: None

**3. Approval of the Minutes from the April 8, 2026 Regular Meeting, and April 8, 2026 Executive Session Meeting** – Steve Seiver made a motion to approve the minutes. Jerry Leibovitz seconded the motion, all in favor, the motion passes.

### **4. Other Business** –

Johnson shared that it has been a challenging week and expressed disappointment in not advancing to a second interview. He requested feedback from the board regarding potential areas for improvement in his application and interview process.

### **5. Public Comment** –

Kami Williams, a dispatcher with 25 years of experience, expressed support for Chris's leadership, noting improvements in staffing, reduced turnover, and progress in training and recruitment. She stated it was disheartening that he was not selected for a second interview and encouraged the board to seek input from staff and reconsider the decision if possible. She also noted concerns about ongoing overtime demands.

Kristen Oberlander echoed these comments, stating that QCOMM employees are frustrated and believe Chris is qualified, citing his positive impact. She expressed concerns about continued overtime, potential staff uncertainty due to leadership changes, and the perception that recent progress may be reversed.

**6. Executive Session** – Vitas asked for a motion to go into executive session per section 5 ILCS 120/2(C)(1) for appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees. Steve Regenwether made a motion to go into executive session. Jerry Leibovitz seconded the motion. Roll call was taken

with Steve Seiver, Mark Rothert, Bob Vitas, Jerry Leibovitz, Chief Ramsey, Chief Karzin, Chief Regenwether, and Chief Radosevich present.
