

CPJSP is a Rwandan National Non-Governmental Organization. It stands for « *Centre de Promotion des Jeunes pour Sortir de la Pauvreté* » , which means a center for the promotion of the youth for getting out of poverty. CPJSP has a motto that says « *Help Me to help Myself* ».

Established in 2007 with the law No 20/2000 of the 26th July, 2000 which regulates the non profit organizations. CPJSP was created after observing that a big number of youth in the region suffer from a high rate of unemployment and life was so difficult due to lack of sufficient professional and technical competences and financial means.

In 2013, CPJSP was legally registered in the Rwanda Government Board (RGB). In 2016 CPJSP KAMONYI TVET SCHOOL was accredited by WDA
