

**CONSTITUTION
of the
JEFFERSON COUNTY RETIRED TEACHERS ASSOCIATION**

- Article I **Name.** The name of this organization shall be the Jefferson County Retired Teachers Association.
- Article II **Mission.** The mission of JCRTA shall be to:
- A. advance the interests and welfare of retired teachers in Jefferson County and to assist retired teachers in maintaining identity with the teaching profession
 - B. support and promote the legislative agenda of KRTA
 - C. further the cause of public education through volunteerism and contributions
 - D. cooperate with the KRTA in securing desirable active representation on the Board of Trustees of the Teachers Retirement System
- Article III **Affiliation.** The Jefferson County Retired Teachers Association shall function as a district of the Kentucky Retired Teachers Association and maintain affiliation with the National Retired Teachers Association.
- Article IV **Membership.** Membership shall be open to any retired teacher or administrator formerly employed in Kentucky. Any person in or out of the state interested in the welfare of retired teachers may become an associate member without voting rights. JCRTA is a volunteer association and members shall not be paid for services rendered.
- Article V **Government.** The following elected officers shall constitute the Executive Board: President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer and KRTA Representative.
- Article VI **Amendments.** The constitution may be amended by the majority vote of the members present at any meeting of the Association after the amendment has had a reading at two previous meetings of the Association.
