  - AAP Section on Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine is inviting every hospital that takes care of infants to participate in a National Perinatal COVID-19 (NPC-19) Registry by submitting de-identified maternal and neonatal data as it pertains to perinatal COVID-19.
  - We are in need of more evidence about the relative risks of transplacental, perinatal, and postnatal transmission of this disease as well as about the efficacy of infection control practices.
