NLCAH Student Driver Guidelines

- Students must present a copy of their current driver's license and vehicle insurance card.
- Student drivers will be assigned a parking spot and must park in their assigned space.
- Student drivers must proceed immediately to their assigned spot after entering campus.
- Student drivers and any passengers must exit the vehicle and enter the school as soon as the vehicle is parked.
- Student drivers must wait until all vehicles have lined up to exit campus before leaving their parking spot.
- Car Trouble which results in tardiness or absenteeism, is NOT an excused absence.
- If a student is tardy because of traffic congestion, it is considered an unexcused tardy to school. Student drivers should allow ample time to drive to school and be in their 1st period class before 8:30 am.
- Prior written permission is required if a student driver desires to transport passengers. The driver's parent or guardian must submit a note giving permission for their son/daughter to transport the specific passenger. The passenger's parent or guardian must submit a note giving permission for their son/daughter to ride to and from school with the specific driver. The passenger will then be added to the driver's account.
- Students may not transfer their driving permit to any other individual.
- Students may not duplicate a driving permit.
- Student drivers are responsible for the safe operation of their vehicle.
- Student drivers may not cause unnecessary noise i.e. repeatedly engaging their horn in non-emergency situations, playing loud music, revving their engines.
- All vehicles on the school campus are subject to be searched by school administration or security.
- Failure to follow driving guidelines may result in disciplinary consequences.
- Students must display their driving permit on their rear view mirror at all times while on campus on days when school is in session. Students who do not display their driving permit will have a warning tag placed on their window.
- Student drivers must obey all posted traffic directional signs and must comply with posted speed limits.
- Student drivers must keep their vehicles under control and within the defined driving lanes.
- Student drivers must yield to other drivers and be respectful of other drivers, parents, and staff.

Driving privileges may be revoked for any of the following:

- Transporting other students without prior approval.
- Leaving the building or property without the permission from the main office.
- Students are not permitted in the parking lot during the school day without permission from the main office.
- Improper use of the permit (e.g., transporting unapproved riders, lending a permit, etc.).
- Poor school attendance/tardiness.
- School misbehavior or discipline issues.
- Violation of any guidelines set above.
