Beginning in the ninth grade, students in high school are required to complete a minimum of 20 Volunteer/Community Service hours per year.

By the end of Senior year, the student will have completed at least 80 hours of volunteer service.

NLCAH will provide opportunities throughout the year for students to gain some hours of volunteer service, however, the student is responsible for finding and completing volunteer hours on their own. Summer is a great time to volunteer!

Summer hours will be applied to the school year that follows.

- High School students must present their completed volunteer hours at the end of each school year; the deadline to submit all volunteer hours is the first Friday of May of that academic year.
- HS students must track, log, and receive an authorized signature for each completed volunteer service.
- Volunteer service must include: Name of organization, address, volunteer coordinator name, phone number, and/or email address.
