

## New Life Christian Academy Hybrid Decision Tree for people with Covid-19 Symptoms

Individual will be sent home or denied entry if that individual displays new onset or worsening of following signs/symptoms:	Any individuals who themselves either: are test-confirmed to have COVID-19, or experience the symptoms of COVID-19:	For people with a COVID-19 diagnosis without a lab test OR people with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 without a medical evaluation (e.g., monitoring symptoms at home):	Negative test result but symptoms with no other diagnosis:
<ul> <li>Have they recently begun experiencing any of the following in a way that is not normal for them?</li> <li>Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit</li> <li>Loss of taste or smell</li> <li>Cough</li> <li>Difficulty breathing</li> <li>Shortness of breath</li> <li>Fatigue</li> <li>Headache</li> <li>Chills</li> <li>Sore throat</li> <li>Congestion or runny nose</li> <li>Shaking or exaggerated shivering</li> <li>Significant muscle pain or ache</li> <li>Diarrhea</li> <li>Nausea or vomiting</li> </ul>	Must stay at home throughout the infection period, and cannot return to campus until the school system screens the individual to determine any of the below conditions for campus re-entry have been met: In the case of an individual who was diagnosed with COVID-19, the individual may return to school when all three of the following criteria are met:  • at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);  • the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath);  • at least ten days have passed since symptoms first appeared	In the case of an individual who has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and who is not evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, such individual is assumed to have COVID-19, and the individual may not return to the campus until the individual has completed the same three-step set of criteria the individual may return to school when all three of the following criteria are met:  • at least one day (24 hours) has passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications);  • the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); at least ten days have passed since symptoms first appeared	Stay home at least 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND until no fever for at least 24 hours without medication AND improvement of other symptoms. Siblings and household members also stay home for 14 days  PLEASE NOTE  If hospitalized with COVID 19: Quarantine 20 days after discharge and/or be cleared by physician for re-entry.
