

*Please note your terminal must be provisioned by Eureka Payments to run on an IP/WiFi connection, not dial, prior to setting up WiFi connection

First Data FD130 – WiFi Quick Set-Up

Network Settings: “KEY” (password) & “SSID” (network name will be case sensitive).

Note: Case-Sensitive.

Connect a USB keyboard to the terminal to enter the information OR

To change from lowercase and uppercase letters on your FD130 terminal, press and **hold down the Enter Key** (green button) and press **ALPHA**.

Starting at the main screen (Sale/Other)

1. Touch **Orange Wrench Key (upper right corner)**
2. Touch **WiFi**
3. Touch **Security**
4. Enter Password: **766130 Enter**
5. Touch the **drop-down arrow** and select **security mode** (Mostly use: **WPA2-AES**) (i.e., WPA1-TKIP, WPA1-AES or WPA2-AES or select **None** if no key or if password is not needed)
6. Enter **“Key”** (password) or leave blank if password is not needed
7. Enter **“SSID”** (network/username)
8. **Verify** the key and SSID match the access point’s setting, and press **Enter**
9. Touch **Yes** to apply settings and reboot. Terminal will reboot.

Testing Wireless signal strength:

Starting at the main screen (Sale/Other)

1. Touch **Orange Wrench Key (upper right corner)**
 2. Touch **WiFi**
 3. Touch **View Status**
- (Note: Signal strength “-xx db” appears on the first line following the Wi-Fi mode/connection status. Anything within the range of -70db to -20db indicates a strong signal strength.)
