Presidents Report

1 - Shows

8 regular season shows plus regional finals. For a total of 4 weekends of regular shows and 1 weekend for Regional Finals. Up from the year before which was a total of 3 weekends – 2 show weekends plus regionals.

- Mar 26 & 27 - WCAS, Claresholm, AB;
- Apr 2 & 3 - Silverslate, Stavely, AB;
- May 21 & 22 - OAS, Okotoks, AB;
- June 4 & 5 - WCAS, Claresholm, AB; and
- Sept 17 & 18 - Regional Finals at WCAS, Claresholm, AB

2 - Show Changes

Claresholm management moved a show which was originally scheduled for the second week of April to the last week of March due to scheduling conflicts.

After April 2/3 Silverslate weekend Silver Slate management advised that they no longer wished to produce team penning and did not wish to produce the May 21,22nd scheduled show. That show was moved to the Okotoks Ag Society.

The Okotoks show was produced by the Chinook Board and was the largest and best attended of our 4 regular season show weekends.

3 - Show sizes

- 2021- 295 average teams per show weekend
- 2022 – 303 average teams per show weekend
- Up slightly – but more or less steady.

4 - Membership

- Membership took a small dip
- 2021 – 99 members
- 2022 – 93 members

6 – Class/Rules Changes

- Open was run as a handicap and total entries increased to 8
- 7 was also run as a handicap with total entries increased to 8
- 5 class was eliminated the first show and then brought back for the last 3 shows
- 10 class – no changes
- Mentorship class was added to assist in the development of new penners
- Limitation on Cross entries was eliminated
- Mandatory Draw in all classes was instituted

We instituted a clinician series. First installment consisted of mini-clinics conducted at our first show after the penning concluded on Saturday night. The instructors were local trainers Anne Thompson and Jesse O'Brien who donated their time at no cost. The cost of the clinics to members were \$75.

Second installment was a series of clinics conducted by American trainer Cody Ward from Colorado. Cody conducted a series of mini clinics and a full day clinic (on the holiday Monday) at our May Long Weekend show at Okotoks.

The clinics were well received and well attended.

The Chinook Team Penning Association 2022 Show Season proved to be very successful! The show season was reduced to 8 shows instead of the past 14 shows. According to the voice of the membership via surveys, the reduction of shows was implemented. Producers included Silver Slate Arena, Willow Creek Ag Society, and CTPA. CTPA produced one weekend show at the Okotoks Ag Society (Hebson Arena). The first self-produced show in years!! The board felt the show was well attended and this will likely be continued in future show dates. Regional finals were held at Willow Creek Ag Society in Claresholm, AB as usual.

Below are the fee breakdowns that had been approved by the 2022 Board of Directors, and agreed to by show producers:

SHOW OPERATOR'S COMPENSATION

BREAKDOWN OF ENTRY FEE

The breakdown of entry fees of \$156.00 per team in the Open Class shall be as follows:

\$66.50 – Show Operator

\$78.75 – Payout to the Open Class

\$ 7.00 – CTPA Administration Fee

\$ 3.75 – CTPA Surcharge



The breakdown of entry fees of \$141.00 per team in the #10, #7 and #5 Class shall be as follows:

\$66.50 – Show Operator

\$63.75 – Payout

\$ 7.00 – CTPA Administration Fee

\$ 3.75 – CTCPA Surcharge

The breakdown of entry fees of \$75.00 per team in the Senior Youth Class, regardless of the number of teams shall be as follows:

\$40.00 – Show Operator

\$35.00 – Payout

The breakdown of entry fees of \$45.00 per team in the Junior Youth Class, regardless of the number of teams shall be as follows:

1st Place – \$45.00

2nd Place – \$30.00
