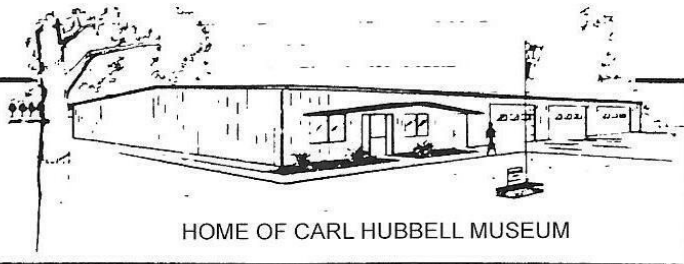

PUBLIC MEETING Posted July 9, 2026 HEARING SET FOR TUESDAY JULY 14, 2026

A special hearing of the Meeker Board of Trustees will be held on Tuesday **July 14, 2026** at **6:00pm** at Meeker City Hall, 510 W. Carl Hubbell Blvd, Meeker, OK.

The Town of Meeker is considering a proposed modest sales tax increase. This public hearing is an opportunity for residents to learn more about the proposal, ask questions, express concerns, and provide input before any decision is made regarding placing the measure before voters

Purpose of Meeting:

The Board of Trustees will receive public comments and input regarding a proposed municipal sales tax increase. The proposed revenue would be used to address current and future municipal needs, including but not limited to public safety, infrastructure maintenance and improvements, municipal building repairs and upkeep, park and cemetery maintenance, equipment replacement, and other public services benefiting the Town of Meeker.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend and provide comments, questions, and recommendations. No final action regarding the proposed sales tax increase will be taken during the public hearing unless otherwise noted on the posted agenda.

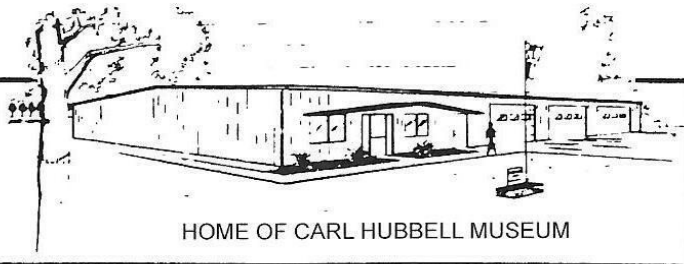

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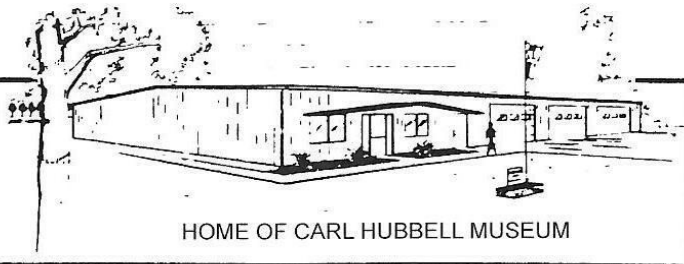
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
