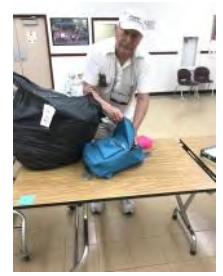

Div. 42 Choir sang us out with a resounding rendition of "For she's a jolly good fellow."

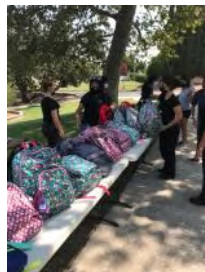

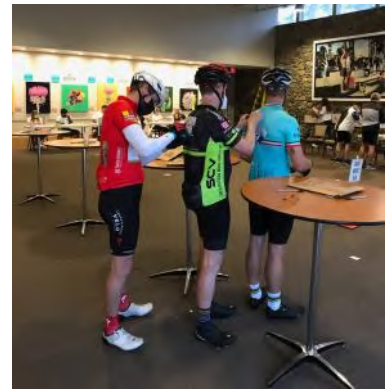

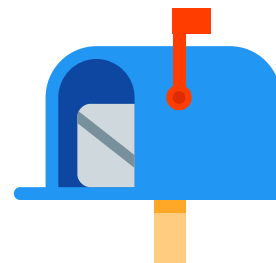
