Nearly \$900,000 has been raised in the 40+ years the race has been held. Used to enhance the learning experience of the students, the funds raised have provided calculators for those students who can't afford them; robotics and fuel cell programs for the science department; updated equipment for the performing arts departments; teaching supplies for the special education department; and many other items that improve and enrich student learning.
