The “2019 Taiwanese Canadian Cultural Festival” will be held at the Richmond Oval Olympic Riverside Plaza for three consecutive days from July 12th to 14th.

This is the second running of the Taiwanese Canadian Cultural Festival (TCCF) after it received a great response since its debut last year. This year, the Taiwanese Canadian Cultural Society has once again invited a number of distinguished Taiwanese and Canadian performing arts groups to showcase the respective art and multicultural beauty of Taiwan and Canada.

The opening ceremony on July 12th is a well-designed, impressive and large-scale event with a youthful, energetic performance from the Taipei First Girls High School Marching Band, followed by Wu-Yuan Taiwanese Opera, I-Lan Youth Orchestra, and Lovedancing Group to exhibit the local and contemporary performing arts of Taiwan.

The organizers invite everyone to join us at the Richmond Oval Olympic Riverside Plaza to experience this wonderful feast of music and dance with main artistic and cultural performances at the “Taiwanese and Canadian Performing Arts Stage” for an exhilarating display of 32 performances.

This year’s artistic director, Wen-Shou Lin, is also the singer-songwriter of the Wu-Yuan Taiwanese Opera troupe. This time, Lin has directed the new drama “Northwestern Rain” and will perform Taiwanese opera in an innovative style to Vancouver audiences. Taiwanese opera is a genre that originated from Taiwanese folklore. After nearly 100 years of development and evolution, Taiwanese opera has developed its own unique charm and performance style.

A lineup of local performers are also invited, including popular performing groups Doe Bender's Quartet, The Kris Jay Trio plus One, Chronicles of False Creek, Urban Myth, Sounds Global Ensemble, and Brazilian Swag. These local performances span across different music scenes, such as popular pop music, jazz, country rock, and modern folk songs.
