Eligibility Requirements:

- A male or female student graduating from a Kent County public high school
- Must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or higher

Application and Required Documents:

Complete the attached application in its entirety, as legibly as possible. If any question does not apply to you, answer the question as N/A for non-applicable. Make sure that all information is current and up to date. Be sure to include the following:

- A Letter of Introduction, expressing your eligibility and your need for the scholarship
- A brief autobiography - must include information relating to future goals, recent community service involvement, academic achievements, and memberships in other organizations and/or clubs.
- Two letters of recommendation from any of the following persons:
 - One letter from any of the following:
 - Principal, Guidance Counselor, Teacher, Professor or Advisor
 - Pastor or Minister
 - Any person other than family members (supervisor, friend, mentor etc.).
 - One letter from a leader of an organization where you served the community in some capacity.
 - Current high school transcript with School Official's signature
 - The FAFSA Submission Summary that reflects financial need

Award Components:

The selected candidate must be willing to interview with the scholarship committee and attend the annual scholarship program to accept the scholarship award. Scholarship funds will be payable directly to the college or university for the Fall Semester upon evidence of attendance and registration. The amount will start at \$2,500 and may increase based on available funds.
