The Coitsville Township Board of Trustees met for a regular meeting on April 17, 2024 at the Coitsville Townhall with the following members present Mr. James Alfano-Chairperson, Mrs. Phyllis Johnson –Vice Chairperson, Mr. Gerald Backo-Trustee.

Call to Order

Mr. Alfano called the meeting to order and asked for roll call and led the pledge of allegiance. He also asked for a moment of silence for the residents that have passed away.

Approval of Minutes Mrs. Johnson made motion to waive the reading and approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting on March 17, 2024 and Special Meeting on March 28, 2024. Mr. Backo seconded the motion. Johnson-aye, Backo-aye Alfano-aye. Motion passed.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

ROAD REPORT Mr. Backo reported that the department has been busy trying to get grass cut and ditches clean. The plan to pick up trees after the upcoming storm. They have also begun work on filling potholes on Township Roads.

ZONING REPORT Mr. Kurilla distributed two bids from contractors for the demolition of the property on Wilson Lane.

Resolution 4-17-2024-03- Mrs. Johnson made a motion to pass resolution in accordance with ORC 955.221 (B) (2) to adopt and enforce resolution to control dogs within the township that are otherwise in conflict with any other provisions of the ORC specifically conditions under which a dog may be tethered outdoors. Mr. Alfano seconded. Johnson-aye, Alfano-aye, Backo-aye Motion Passed.

FIRE REPORT- Chief Warren gave a detailed report that is on file at the Fire Station. He reported that he would be coming to the board next month to sell the old ambulance that is not really being used. He also reviewed the progress on the addition to the Fire Station. He explained that during the process they found the Fire Station needs a new septic system. Mr. Backo is working on getting the new system.

Resolution 4-17-2024-04 Mr. Alfano made a motion to approve up to \$15,000 from the Fire Fund for a new septic system from Romo. Mrs. Johnson seconded the motion. Alfano-aye, Johnson-aye, Backo-aye. Motion passed.

The Chief reported that we received a grant from The State Fire Marshall's for \$11,000 for equipment with no match.

Resolution 4-17-2024-04 Mr. Alfano made a motion increase the equipment 2111-220-740-0000 appropriation by \$11,000. Mrs. Johnson seconded. Alfano-aye, Johnson-aye, Backo-aye. Motion passed.

POLICE REPORT -Chief Morris provided the board with a detailed report for the past month which is on file at the Police Station. He reported that they are really buckling down on speeding on township roads. He reported that the police are also working picking up people on ATV's that are on township roads.
