The Chief has reviewed all the bids to make sure they included everything the township requested and is recommending the township approve the lowest and best bid of \$9,462.00 from Aey Electric.

Mr. Lisko reviewed the recommendation from Chief Brown to accept a donation of \$4,000 from Warren Drescher and \$4,419 from Victory Christian Church to purchase a Lucas Tool for \$8,419 in order to assist with performing CPR.

Mrs. Johnson made a motion to accept the donations of \$4,000 from Warren Drescher and \$4,419.00 from Victory Christian Church in order to purchase a Lucas Tool for the Township Fire Department and to increase the Fire Fund appropriations by \$8,419.00 for the purpose of purchasing the tool and to increase Fire Fund Revenues by \$8,419.00 as a result of the donations.
