Coitsville Asks Lower Speed Limit

Coltsville Township trustees will ask the Ohio Highway Department to reduce the speed limit of U.S. 422 through the township from 60 to 50 m.p.h. to reduce accidents.

Recently elected trustees' chairman John Loboy said the department also will be asked to install turn arrows at the intersection of Routes 422 and 616. Attempts to have the turn arrows installed have been unsuccessful.

Loboy said the township needs more than one full-time deputy but does not have a police levy and is without funds. He said the township gets only \$4.17 returned for each thousand dollars of property valuation.

Trustees, at the recent reorganization meeting, reappointed Ben Hodnicky township deputy sheriff. He will also serve as zoning and building inspector at no additional compensation. An effort will be made to renew a contract with the Mahoning County sheriff's department for police protection.
