
Harmony Home served 766 children and their non-offending family members


- 410 forensic interviews were conducted

# Innovation in Prevention in Education

### Darkness to Light (D2L), Stewards of Children®

In 2014, Harmony Home became a recipient of funding through the Texas Department of Health and Human Services, which has allowed us to begin a 5-year Prevention Campaign, with an ultimate goal of training 5,000 adults in Ector County on how to be more protective and decreasing the chances of a child being a victim of sexual abuse. We have since trained 3,517 adults through the Darkness to Light, Stewards of Children <sup>®</sup> curriculum.

Darkness to Light (D2L) was founded in 2000 and is a nonprofit organization committed to empowering adults on how to prevent child sexual abuse. The curriculum is guided by the vision to create a world where child sexual abuse does not exist. Protecting children is an adult responsibility and education is critical for prevention efforts, as well as a catalyst for larger cultural change. D2L works to end child sexual abuse by educating, raising awareness, sharing resources, and fostering a network of committed prevention advocates. Through the Stewards of Children program, Darkness to Light has trained more than one million adults how to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. Available in 17 countries and taught by a network of over 8,000 volunteer facilitators, it is the largest program of its kind in the world. It is a 2-hour training program that uses real people and real stories featuring a combination of survivor stories, expert advice, and practical guidance. In 2015, 60 training sessions were conducted with a total of 1, 821 individuals, including, local school personnel, faith based community members, day cares, head starts, community child advocates and other non-profit agencies.

## **Champions for Children Conference (C4C)**

Champions 4 Children is an annual conference that began in 2015 and brings in presenters from a variety of fields dealing with child abuse and child abuse prevention, mental health, building stronger families and also child abuse survivors. The conference saw an attendance of 228 and included law enforcement, educators, therapist, counselors, professionals, children and victim's advocates and parents attend. Keynote speakers included Margaret Hoelzer, Jenna Quinn, and Dr. Ray Perryman.

Margaret Hoelzer is a two time Olympian and three-time medalist at the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. She is a survivor of child sexual abuse, an advocate against child abuse and is the National Spokesperson for the National Children's Advocacy Center.

Jenna Quinn is a triumphant survivor of sexual abuse and has become a valiant warrior against sexual abuse of children and adolescents. Republican Representative Tam Parker championed what is now known as "Jenna's Law" in August 2009. "Jenna's Law" passed the state senate unanimously making it the first child abuse prevention law in the U.S. mandating K-12 trainings for students, all school staff, and parents. It addresses sexual abuse and other forms of maltreatment.

Widely regarded as one of the world's most influential and innovative economists, Dr. Ray Perryman is the founder and President of Perryman Group (TPG), an economic and financial analysis firm headquartered in Waco, Texas.

This year, C4C was held on April 8, 2016 with much success and is scheduled again for April 7, 2017.
